If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50 including GST) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

CKC REGULATION: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ELIGIBILITY

Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age and:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

PAYMENT: If not paying via Dogshow.ca, please make Cheque or Money Order payable to Campbell River Dog Fanciers Society

ENTRY LIMIT: These Trials are limited by time. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

Handlers may only enter 1 dog in each component at each level. Dogs can only be entered in Open, Excellent and Masters if they have already obtained the preceding level title.

MOVE UPS: Move ups are not available for this trial.

RIBBONS & AWARDS:

Double Flat Ribbon awarded for Instinct passes

Flat ribbons for all Qualifying Scores

Rosettes awarded for Novice, Open, Excellent, ***first*** Masters Title, and Grand Master Title

Rosettes awarded for Top 3 Qualifying Scores for each component per class

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the rounds.

SCENT DETECTION RULEBOOK: It is up to the individual handler to have reviewed the CKC Scent Detection Rule book prior to the trial. Note: there were changes and updates to the Rule book January 1, 2024.

REMINDERS: That anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.

All dogs are to be on leash while in the parking lot or any areas surrounding the trial venue. Only time a dog may be off leash is during a search and at the discretion of the judge.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are permitted to compete. However, they must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. All participants who crossed the border will have done 14 days of quarantine immediately prior to trial date.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: 1-800-250-8040.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

SITE INFO

No special area will be designated for reactive dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash at all times. Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site. Please, clean up after yourself and your dog. Please note: some search areas accessed by stairs.

NO CONCESSION ON SITE: Restaurants are nearby but not within easy walking distance. Bring your own food, treats and water for you and your dog(s)

CANCELLATION OF EVENT: If the Campbell River Dog Fanciers Society needs to cancel the event due to Provincial or Federal regulations, all entry fees will be returned with the exception of any fees collected by Dogshow.ca.
