4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. A Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to INDIGNITIES of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
- Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be

transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members

SPECIAL AWARDS

The **Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada** is pleased to offer a rosette and prize to the Highest Qualifying Clumber Spaniel in Obedience & Rally Obedience at the PCKC All Breed Obedience & Rally Trials on Sunday.

JUVENILE & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs must be entered in on of the regular classes for the specialty in order to enter sweepstakes. For dogs 4 months and up to but not including 18 months. Each class will be divided by sex. The Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

- 50% remaining of the entry fees for each class will be awarded to the class winner
- 15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best In Sweeps
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps
- Rosette for Best In Sweeps and Best of Opposite Sweeps

Juvenile Classes: 4 – 6 Months; 6 – 9 Months; 9 – 12 Months; 12 – 18 Months.

Veteran Classes: 7 – under 9 Years; 9 - under 11 Years, 11+ Years.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

REGULAR CLASSES

Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Veteran Class	For dogs 7 years old and older, class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed level at National (classes 7-9 years, 9-11 years, 11+ years)
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog between the age of 4months & under 6months on the day of the show
Stud Dog & Get	Stud Dog & two(2) ore more of his get. Stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Get MUST be entered in a regular class. Baby Puppies not eligible.
Brood Bitch & Progeny	Brood Bitch & two(2) or more of her progeny. Brood bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Progeny MUST be entered in a regular class. Baby Puppies not eligible.
Hunting Dog/Bitch	Any dog/bitch that has earned at least a leg towards JH, SH, MH title under AKC/CKC rules & regulations. Only dogs with these legs/titles qualify. Must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only to compete.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and older. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in non-regular classes.
Brace	2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) judges on as identical a pair as possible. Dogs competing must be entered in a regular class or exhibitbition only

ALTERED CLASSES

Altered Male	Dogs 6 months and older, must be surgically neutered
Altered Female	Dogs 6 months an older, must be surgically spayed

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

A class dog awarded best of breed at the national specialty show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of and accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
2. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
3. The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
4. In no case may a dog under 4 months of age be allowed within the show/trial precincts
5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
6. Only dogs entered in the Shows will be permitted on the grounds.
7. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
8. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and on the site.**
9. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the CSCC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
10. The Pictou County Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show promises.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). **Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.**

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.**

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. Please forward your request to:

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. CKC HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.
