OUR RALLY JUDGE



Ms Shirley Hubenig 215 - 44th Ave. N.W. Calgary, AB, T2K 0J2

Shirley has been involved in showing, breeding, training, trialing and teaching obedience for over 40 years. She began with Siberian Huskies and owned and trialed the first Utility titled Siberian Husky in Canada and bred and trained Sibes for 13 years. For the past 30 some years Dobermans have been her love, taking 4 to their Dual Championships. Her first Doberman was a multi BIS and BISS boy who was top obedience Doberman in Canada his first year out. During these years Shirley was also a handler showing over 20 different breeds to their championships.

Shirley now resides with a 4 yr. old Dobie boy who finished his championship as a Junior Puppy and went High in Trial last year at the Canadian Doberman National Specialty trial and now working on his Rally Excellent. Shirley is also the proud owner of a Standard Poodle who completed her Championship as a Junior Puppy and her CD with 3 High in Classes and a High in Trial and achieved her Rally Novice, Advanced and Excellent all in one year.

Shirley is a CKC licensed obedience and rally judge and is also licensed for Group 3, and is on permit for the top $\frac{1}{2}$ of Group 7.

Run-Offs and tie scores (CKC obedience trial rules 8.9)

^{8.9.1} In case of a tie, the dogs shall be re-tested again by having them perform individually, all or the same part of one or more of the regular exercises. In the case of a tie in Utility, the dogs shall be tested again by performing individually all or the same part of the signal exercise. The original scores shall not be changed.

^{8.9.2} In the case of a tie the judge shall inform the exhibitors involved and allow a reasonable warm up period.

^{8.9.3} In case of a tie for High in Trial, the dogs shall be tested by performing the Heel Free exercise individually.

^{8.9.4} The officiating judge of a trial must judge any run-off for High in Trial. In the event of two or more judges officiating at a single trial, the club shall designate in the premium list which judge will judge any run-off for HIT. Each Judge is responsible for breaking ties in the classes that they judge.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries

Overpayment of entry fees will be considered a donation to the club. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any returned cheques.

Attention foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to inconsistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques 'payable in Canadian funds', or 'at par', as the banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

All entries must contain complete information as required by CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee, in full, and all listing fees where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-1-23)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services, then Forms Online. If submitting a membership application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the
 Veterinarian or the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because
 of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be
 made. Overpayments will not be refunded.
- ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN THESE TRIALS COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a veterinarian's certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR CLEARLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The LRCC, Inc. does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL. Receipts, judging schedules, and armband numbers will be available at www.dogshow.ca.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition, the dog must wear a collar and be on a leash a
 maximum of 6' or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.
- ALL EMPTY RINGS ARE TO BE KEPT FREE OF DOGS.
- AN EXHIBITOR HAS THE RIGHT TO WITHDRAW AN ENTRY. This Notice of Withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Trial Secretary on or before the official closing date and time as published in the premium list.
- ALL MISCELLANEOUS LISTED BREED DOGS MUST HAVE A CKC MISCELLANEOUS CERTIFICATION NUMBER <u>PRIOR TO ENTERING ANY CKC EVENT.</u>
- IN TRANSIT PERMITS WILL BE AVAILABLE from the Trial Secretary if needed. Dogs not entered in the trials in regular classes or exhibition only will not be permitted in the building without an In Transit Permit.
- PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN) ALLOWS an unregisterable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. For more information or to apply for a PEN, visit www. ckc.ca
- THE LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB OF CANADA, Inc., its members and volunteers will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the
 exhibitors and dogs, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs,
 exhibitors, or patrons.
- THE TRIAL SUPERINTENDENT HAS THE AUTHORITY to expel any dog deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. There will be
 no refund for dogs that are expelled.

CKC Obedience Trial rules - 20.7 "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

OFFICIAL CLASSES - OBEDIENCE

The following **CKC OBEDIENCE** classes will be provided:

Novice A

This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in

this class.

Novice B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the

group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

Novice C

This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

Open A

This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.

Open B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility Class are also eligible for entry in this class.

This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D.. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned

a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class.

Utility B This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A

and Utility B at the same trial.

Utility A

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES - OBEDIENCE

Veterans Class: for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher and is 7 years or age or older on the day of the trial.

OFFICIAL CLASSES - RALLY OBEDIENCE

The following **CKC RALLY OBEDIENCE** classes will be provided:

Rally Novice A

Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs that have earned titles or are not the owners may enter in the Novice B class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Rally Novice B Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced A This class is for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) titleor any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced B This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (RE). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judge off leash and the dog must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent B This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely. Any person is allowed to handle a dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

For information only: Rally Advanced Excellent title -- Upon completion of the Rally Excellent title, qualifying scores may be accumulated from Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B to earn the Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE) title. To receive the RAE title, a dog must qualify ten (10) times in both Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent at the same trial. The title will appear at the end of the dog's name and a numeric designation will indicate the number of times the dog has met the requirements, i.e. RAE2, RAE3, etc.

To be eligible to compete in these obedience or rally obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or de-barked.

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to know the CKC rules governing rally or obedience trials.


