CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

The following Regular classes will be offered, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

ALTERED – For the purposes of this section, “altered” shall mean dogs that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. Winners of their perspective altered class compete for points for Altered Champion Status. All rules and regulation in the Conformation Rules & Regulations shall apply to this class unless otherwise specified in this section.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

ELECTRICITY

Power is available inside the building at no charge for drying dogs. However, PLEASE NOTE: RV's need to be self contained as there are no outside outlets. There is also free bathing facilities in the building for dogs as well as people showers.

BENCHING

As always, benching is free HOWEVER, this year we are excited to offer 5 private dressing rooms (for a fee). A deposit is required and will be returned after an inspection from the Show Super for cleanliness and damages. If utilizing the free benching, we ask that you don't spread out as space is still limited. Benching will open at 1:00 pm on Friday.

PLEASE NOTE THAT PLASTIC WILL BE REQUIRED UNDER ALL XPENS AND WIRE CRATES

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 5397 Eglinton Avenue W Suite 101 Etobicoke ON, M9C 5K6

- 1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW.** The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows, which will be governed by CKC rules. No entry fees will be refunded if you are removed from event
- 2.** Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3.** The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4.** A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5.** Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are MOUNTAIN DAYLIGHT TIME.
- 7.** The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8.** A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$107.80 + GST (CKC member) or \$161.60 + GST (non-member) which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9.** Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10.** For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only.
- 11.** No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12.** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13.** The Club has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with these shows, including spectators. The police can and will be called to deal with any form of abuse be it verbal or physical.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all *Conformation Rules and Regulations* can be found at www.ckc.ca

1. This show is held INDOORS at the **CENOVUS ENERGY ARENA** in the **COLD LAKE ENERGY CENTRE**.
2. This is a limited entry conformation show.
3. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.)
4. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 8 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the LKOC, that make it impossible to open or complete the show.
5. **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:**
 - a. An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
9. The show building will be OPEN at 1:00 p.m. on Friday for exhibitors. Booths may be set up after 11 a.m. Friday.
10. **ON SHOW DAYS** The show building will be open at **6:00 a.m. and close at 10:00 pm.**
11. **DOGS WILL NOT** be permitted to remain in the building overnight
12. **Neither LKOC or the Cold Lake Energy Centre shall be responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or Show ground property.**
13. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
14. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online.
15. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. **You must clean up after your dog.**
16. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show, or "IN TRANSIT"
17. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The LKOC Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
18. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted on the grounds.
19. **LKOC has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with LKOC Shows, including spectators.**
20. **The RCMP can and will be called to deal with any form of abuse be it verbal or physical altercation or threats of violence against members of Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club, Club Volunteers, Staff of Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club, Exhibitors or Staff of the Cold Lake Energy Centre, this also including spectators and vendors**

IMPORTANT RULES IMPOSED BY THE CITY OF COLD LAKE

LIQUOR LAW – there is to be no drinking alcohol in public places. This includes inside the building.

CAMPFIRES – NO open campfires are permitted on the show grounds or camping area.

DAMAGE – Our club will be held responsible for the cost of repairing any damage. Please ensure that you don't damage the parkland area in and around where you park your RV's. **NO DUMPING OF GREY OR BLACK WATER.**

LITTERING – Our Club will have a large financial responsibility to the City if it is found that people have not cleaned up after their dogs. City By-Law will be checking and any infractions will be charged to our Club. **KINDLY EVERYONE..... PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!!!!**

OTHER EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.6

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. has an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. with the exception of Baby Puppy, if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

FROM THE CKC RULES AND REGULATIONS: 13.3 Judging of Altered Classes 13.3.1 The breed standards for each breed shall be followed except as defined in this section 44 **13.3.2** All disqualifications shall apply except for those that disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. **13.3.3** Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding of awards for lack of merit is encouraged. **13.4 Eligibility for Altered Classes 13.4.1** Eligibility for the altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six (6) months of age that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. **13.4.2** Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the altered class

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

INDIGNITIES - SECTION 19.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.



ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period of time in the future, including permanently.

The RCMP can and will be called to deal with any form of abuse be it verbal or physical altercation or threats of violence against members of Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club, Club Volunteers or staff of Lakeland Kennel & Obedience Club or Staff of the Cold Lake Energy Centre.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.

Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles
- intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking
- physically abusing or threatening abuse
- criticising a participant persistently
- constantly belittling a person's opinions.



This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, Facebook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram.
