No post dated cheques accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.



Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes – it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR SWEDISH VALLHUNDS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy Senior Puppy 12 to 18 Months

Canadian Bred Bred by Exhibitor Open

Veterans Specials Only Exhibition Only

Sexually Altered

Note: Veterans class will be divided 7-10 years, 10-13 years & 13+ years

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy – shall be for puppies 3 -6 months

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed & colour

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for all dogs between the ages of 3 –18 months on the day of the Specialty and shall be eligible to compete regardless of place of birth. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular official classes or, in the case of Baby Puppies, in the Baby Puppy class.

There will be four classes in all, divided by sex. 3-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 - 10 years, 10 - 13 years, 13+ years of age

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes.

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% remaining of the entry fees will be awarded to the class winner.

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

SPECIALTY TROPHIES AND ROSETTES

Through the generosity of its members, friends and Purina Pro Plan, the Swedish Vallhund Club of Canada will offer a suitable Prize and Rosette for each of the following

Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Winners Male, Winners Female, Best Puppy and Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best sexually Altered, Best of Opposite Sex Sexually altered, Stud dog, Brood Female, Brace.

1st through 4th in the regular classes will receive a flat ribbon.

Award of Merit: At the judge's discretion, after the Best of Breed judging, one award of Merit will be offered for every (10) dogs competing for Best of Breed.

A Select Male & a Select Female may be awarded at the judge's discretion.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

Best of Breed - Elrond Kennel

Best of Opposite Sex - Foxberry Kennel

Best Puppy - Vastgota Kennel

Best Veteran - Attvalla Kennel

Best Female in Specialty – Ebba Trophy (Sweden). (This shall be the same as either BOB or BOS) Winners Male – Feldberg Kennel

Winners Female – Fennican Geeba Gerbera Trophy (Finland)

Perpetual trophies are the property of the Swedish Vallhund Club of Canada and can never be won outright. They will remain with the SVCC and a keeper trophy will be given. It is the exhibitors responsibility to pick up prizes the day of the Show. None will be mailed.

SPECIALTY CATALOGUE

Catalogues will be available from trial and show secretary on a pre-order basis only - \$ 5.00. Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Conformation Show Rules Sec. 19.7)
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the PCKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made
- Only dogs entered in the Show will be permitted on the show premises.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the
 progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that
 this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
