## Junior Handling

### **SUNDAY, MARCH 23**

*Held under CKC Rules. Judge to be announced.*

#### **Class Structure (Age Requirements)**

**1. PEE WEE**

For handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age. Optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

**2A. JUNIOR NOVICE**

For handlers 7 to 10 years who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

**2B. JUNIOR OPEN**

For handlers 7 to 10 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.

**3A. INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS**

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.

**3B. INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS**

For handlers 11 to 14 years of age, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.

**4A. SENIOR NOVICE CLASS**

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

**4B. SENIOR OPEN CLASS**

For handlers 15 years of age and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.

**5. BEST OVERALL**

Optional at the discretion of the host club.

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show.

Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler. If Pee Wee handler cannot lift dog, it is not appropriate in size for the competitor.

## Entry Information

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries close 8 P.M. (ET) Wednesday, March 5, 2025, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.**
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

---

## General Information

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Scarborough Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
6. SHOW PRECINCTS: The show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges, exhibitors and handlers.

**NOTE: The Show Superintendent may restrict the placing of chairs, tables and crates. No private exercise pens during show hours.**

---

## Refund Policy

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

---

## Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

TCNs can be obtained through your CKC member portal or by contacting the CKC.

**Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.**

---

## Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$64.00 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

---

## Non-Member Participation Fee

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170.00 plus applicable taxes.
  - b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
  - c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
  - d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

## **Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes**

### **Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex)**

4 to 6 months, 6 to 9 months, 9 to 12 months, 12-15 Months and 15-18 Months

*To enter Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes at this specialty.*

### **Veteran Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex)**

7 to 10 years, 10 to 13 years and 13 years and over

*To enter Veteran Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes or for Exhibition Only at this specialty.*

Winners from each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

### **Prize Money:**

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of total entry fee.

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 20% of total entry fee.

First-place winners in each class will divide the remaining 30% of the total entry fee.

25% retained by the club for administration.

## **Junior Handling**

Held under CKC Rules.

Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the Specialty Show provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so.

Through the generosity of its members and friends, the Club VI Ontario will offer suitable prizes and / or rosettes, for the following awards: Best Overall, Best Junior and Best Senior Junior Handler.

## CH and Champion Points

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*\*includes the dog awarded Winners*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

**Section 15.1.11** A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges, with at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

---

## GCH and Grand Champion Points

**Section 15.2.1** The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

**15.2.2** Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

**Section 15.2.3** To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at group level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### **Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)**

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.



### **Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)**

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

### **Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)**

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

---

## **GCHEx and Grand Champion Excellent Points**

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

**Section 15.3.2** To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

**Section 15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

## **CORRECTING SHOW RESULTS**

**Section 9.9** The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

---

### Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

**Section 4.7.1** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

---

### Moving Class Dog to Specials Only

**Section 8.9** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

---

### Moving from Specials Back to the Classes

**Section 8.10.5** A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.

---



## HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.

## SHOW ETIQUETTE

*Exhibitors, handlers, judges and assistants are expected to participate with honesty, fairness and integrity, ever mindful of the practice of "good sportsmanship," before, during and after this show.*

- Any person engaging in an activity that might be considered malicious, threatening or constitutes bullying, including but not limited to social media, will be asked to leave this show without compensation and will be banned from any future shows held by this club.
- Any exhibitor who allows his/her dog to defecate or urinate inside or outside the building other than in the designated Exercise Area without immediately cleaning up or arranging for a cleanup may not be permitted to exhibit at future shows or trials held by this club. Please co-operate in keeping the show site clean.
- PLEASE ABIDE BY THE NO SMOKING RULES OF THE COMPLEX. Absolutely no smoking or vaping inside the building or within 30 feet of an entrance/exit.

## STATEMENT ON BULLYING

### ZERO TOLERANCE

Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Scarborough Kennel Club shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with the CKC and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit.

### DEFINITION OF BULLYING

Refers to a range of behaviours in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group.

#### Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an Individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles
