## CONFORMATION JUDGES



**Dana Cline**  
**USA**

In the late 1960's, Dana Cline's parents gave him his first Great Dane and from that moment he knew that he would have a lifetime of involvement with this breed and with dogs. As a young child he exhibited in 4H, training in both obedience and conformation. He found the dog show world in his teenage years, spending nearly every weekend traveling to shows, helping professional handlers and handling dogs for friends with other breeds as well. While his main interest was always in Great Danes, he worked hard to learn about other breeds and to become more active in all breeds. All of his weekends spent at dogs shows eventually led him to a career as a professional handler, where he specialized in Danes and sight hounds, but also handling various other breeds along the way. Breeding has always been a favorite aspect of this sport for Mr. Cline and currently breeds and exhibits Italian Greyhounds. He has bred over 100 champions in numerous breeds, primarily Great Danes, but also Borzoi, German Wirehaired Pointers, Miniature Bull Terriers, Bull Terriers, Beagles, Italian Greyhounds, and Tibetan Mastiffs. Mr. Cline is also a Breeder of Merit. He was a long-time member of the Great Dane Club of America and a member of the Italian Greyhound Club of America.

Mr. Cline is an All-Breed Judge. He has judged in a number of foreign countries, multiple National Specialties, as well as many of the country's top shows. He was also the Recipient of the 2017 AKC Judge of the Year. He has judged many groups at the AKC/Royal Canin National Championship Shows and was the 2021 Best In Show Judge.



**Ricardo**  
**Saldaña Solórzano**  
**Mexico**

Born in México City, Ricardo Saldaña Solórzano grew in a family of dog lovers. At 11 years old, he started participating in Dog Shows as owner-handler. Later he became a Stewart for the Federación Canófila Mexicana (Mexican Kennel Club), activity which he performed during many years; in this time, he was steward of judges all around the world. He participated actively like steward and judge in the 1978, 1984, 1999 and 2007 World Dog Shows in México City. He was member of the Board of the Federación Canófila Mexicana for 20 years. He has represented México in the General Assembly of the FCI meetings in Germany, Switzerland, Argentina, Belgium and México.

At 16 years old, he was judging his first match show. He obtained his first license to judge in 1980 and in 1988 he was credited as judge with international license to judge all breed by the FCM and the FCI. He was judges in more of 40 countries, in many of the most prestigious shows. He was judge in Worlds Dog Shows; Royal Shows in Australia; New Zealand and South Africa Championships; many of the most prestigious shows in USA and Canada; International FCI Shows in Asia, Sud America and Europe.

He was President of the School of Judges of the Federación Canófila Mexicana; he has organized and participated in many seminars and conference to prepared new judges. For 15 years he was President and Show Chairman of the Club Canófilo de Michoacán, in Morelia. He was owned dogs of various breeds like English Cocker Spaniel, Smooth Fox Terrier, Xoloitzcuintle, Toy Poodles, Pomerania and Smooth Chihuahueño; he has bred Labrador Retriever and American Cocker Spaniel. But his breed is the Pugs.

He has breed pugs for over 30 years, many of which have become Mexican, international champions and BIS winners, breeding many Pugs winners around the World and the top winners Pugs in México.

He was judging a Pug specialized show in Brazil, New Zealand, Australia, Russia and Argentina. He wrote for a dog show magazine in México, Argentina and USA and is a professional journalist, producer of television, radio, social media and specialist in institutional marketing. He has a very famous radio Network every night in Morelia, city where he lives in México.

**Juan  
Miranda Saucedo  
Mexico**

Architect & Social Media Influencer born in Mexico City, Along with his parents, Juan is the breeder, owner and handler of Afghans of Damos (Home of The top winning hounds in the history of Mexico since 1980). His judging career started as the youngest FCI All Breed International Judge. As a Junior Handler he won the World Championship three times, earned third place at Crufts and was a finalist at Westminster Kennel Club.

Mr. Miranda's great achievements have been worldwide; twice Best in Show at the FCI Americas & Caribbean Section Winner, Reserve Best in Show at FCI European Dog Show Winner 2017, World Dog Show 2022 Group Winner, Best of Breed and Award of Merit five times at the Afghan Hound Club of America's National Specialties, three times Best of Breed at the AKC National Championship Show, Best Opposite Sex and Award of Merit at WKC.

In Mexico Afghans of Damos won the Best Dog of the Year, Best Mexican Breeder of the Year and four times Champion of Champions Winner. He has also obtained the title BIS with other breeds owned and co-owned: Whippet, Doberman, Pembroke Welsh Corgi, Brittany Spaniel, Xoloitzcuintli, The top winning Pomeranian and Saluki in the history of Mexico.

Mr. Miranda has judged the five continents, included; Westminster Kennel Club 2022 & 2025, The World Dog Show, twice The AKC National Championship, The Afghan Hound World Congress, FCI Section Shows. Best in Show at the Sidney Royal in Australia. Sighthound & Toy & Working Specialties and National Specialties in USA, Europe and Australia.



**Judy McVeigh  
CANADA**

Growing up in Edmonton, Alberta my family always had purebred dogs. My Uncle was fascinated with Scotties and when I showed an interest in the breed, he purchased me one of my own. After going to a dog show, I decided that this was something that I was interested in pursuing. I joined the Edmonton Junior Kennel Club and learned about all aspects of showing, not just what to do in the ring. This group was very active and put on several fun matches. I also learned that despite an excellent pedigree, my dog didn't have what she needed to succeed in the show ring.

In the 1970s it became obvious that this wasn't just a passing fancy, and the family began the search for a show dog. I began showing different breeds and assisting professional handlers whenever possible.

Over the years, I have been proud to have bred and exhibited Scotties under the MacIfflen kennel name. Many of these dogs reached the top levels in the breed and were group and Best in Show winners. Over the years, many other breeds were added to our household. My daughter added top winning Miniature Wire Haired Dachshunds. My son, a top winning Junior handler, continued with Scotties and added B.I.S. winning Wire Fox Terriers to our breeding program. This breed still shares my heart and my bed today.

I decided in 1990 to apply for my judge's license. Unfortunately, family circumstances put my judging career on hold for several years while I took time out to raise my family. I was involved in the formation of the Northern Alberta Judges' Study group and was an active member in this group for many years. This group predated the formation of the Canadian Dog Judges Association and was formed to educate Judges and interested breeders about different breeds. I still am actively involved in this judges' education group and enjoy planning and hosting seminars and mentoring

new judges. I still enjoy working with Juniors and will support them in any way I can. Many of my past Juniors have become wonderful successes in their own breeds and continue in the sport as adults. I am extremely proud to have played a small part in their success.

Despite the restrictions that Covid put on our world, I achieved All-Breed status in 2020. I have had the privilege of judging dogs across Canada, the United States and Australia, and Puerto Rico. In 2023, after 42 years as a teacher and administrator, I retired from the education field. My husband, Brian Bindon, and I share our home with 2 retired Wire Fox Terriers and a very precocious Scottie puppy. We enjoy traveling and time with friends and family, especially our Grandchildren.

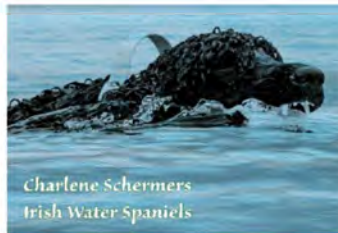

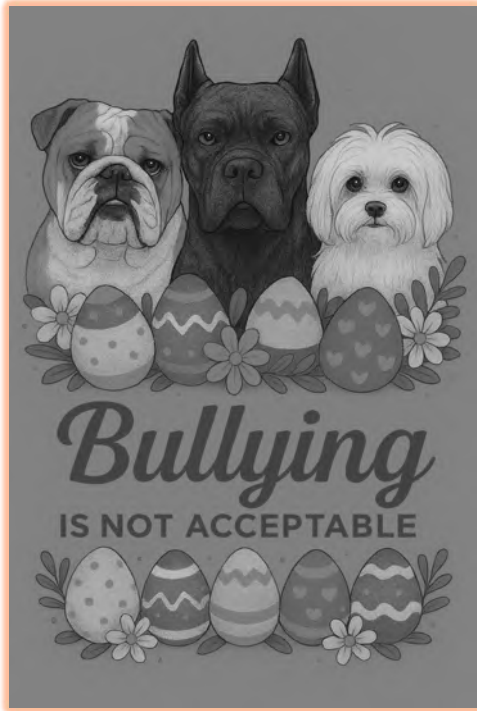

A formal report will be filed with the **Canadian Kennel Club (CKC)**, and the Disciplinary Committee has the authority to take further action, including suspension from future events or permanent exclusion.

**Definition of Bullying:** *Bullying includes any repeated behavior — deliberate or unconscious — that demeans, intimidates, humiliates, or harms another individual. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and*

*sometimes as part of a group of people.*

### **Examples include:**

- *Insulting a person's skills, appearance, or habits*
- *Spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo*
- *Berating, belittling, or ridiculing an individual*
- *Public criticism intended to embarrass*
- *Giving insulting nicknames*
- *Humiliating jokes or pranks*
- *Undermining or impeding someone's work*
- *Intimidating gestures or physical posturing*
- *Mocking accents, abilities, or mannerisms*
- *Yelling or shouting to intimidate*
- *Pestering, spying, stalking, or invading privacy*
- *Physical abuse or threats*
- *Persistent criticism or belittling of opinions*



This policy applies to **interpersonal and electronic communications**, including: **Email, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, text messaging, and any online discussion involving RDDKC events.**

### **CKC Code of Ethics Reminder**

A positive environment at CKC events depends on **good sportsmanship, respect, and kind conduct** from all exhibitors and participants.

## General Rules and Information

A description of all **Conformation, Obedience and Rally Classes** and **Rule and Regulations** can be found at [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca)

1. This show is held INDOORS at the **Westerner Agricentre Building, Westerner Park.**
2. This is an **UNLIMITED** entry Conformation dog show. Performance shows entry **LIMITED** to the timing restrictions of each judge.
3. The show building will be **OPEN at 4 PM on Thursday** for exhibitors. Vendor booths may be set up after **1 PM** on Thursday.
4. **DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES** are permitted at this show for Obedience and Rally Obedience. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in performance events with CCN.
5. **RALLY-OBEDIENCE** will be held in a **45' x 60' ring**. OBEDIENCE will be held in a **45' x 45' ring**. The Precincts of the Rally trials are the ring and the immediate area surrounding the ring. Only dogs entered in the trials are permitted within the Precincts of the Rally trials.
6. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, judge or show official, entered incorrectly, barred from competition by an act of the RDDKC or CKC, or due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the CKC or RDDKC except as follows:
  - a) Trial fees will be refunded only in cases where a bitch entered in the Obedience or Rally Obedience trial comes into season within 10 days preceding the trial.

To qualify for a refund:

    - A veterinary certificate must be provided, confirming that the bitch came into season within the stated 10-day period.
    - The certificate must be submitted to the **Show Secretary** prior to the commencement of judging for the relevant trial.
7. **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:**
  - a) An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
  - b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
  - c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
8. Westerner Park staff will **lock the building doors at 11:00 PM** each evening of the show and **reopen them at 6:15 AM** the following morning. Please note:
  - **No personnel will be on-site overnight.**
  - **Dogs and property left in the building are at the owner's own risk.**
  - The **Red Deer & District Kennel Club** and its affiliates **assume no responsibility or liability** for any accident, injury, loss, or misfortune that may occur to dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or their property.

We encourage all participants to take appropriate precautions to safeguard their animals and belongings.

9. All **EMPTY** rings are to be kept free of dogs, unless authorized by the RDDKC.
10. Entries will **NOT BE ACKNOWLEDGED** after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts are available online.
11. Dogs must be **exercised only in designated areas** provided by the Westerner Park and RDDKC. Anyone found **exercising dogs outside these designated areas** or **failing to clean up after their dog** will be **excluded from participation** in the show or trial.
12. All dogs in the show building must either be **REGISTERED** in the show, or **"IN TRANSIT"**. The RDDKC does not permit other animals in the Show Building.
13. All entries must be **CLEARLY** filled out. The RDDKC or the Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
14. **SIGNS** advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted in the benching area or around the rings.
15. **PARKING** is permitted in designated areas **ONLY**. Fire lanes are marked and a towable offence. **DO NOT park in any fire lane**. **PERFORMANCE** exhibitors may park in the North lots. **CONFORMATION** exhibitors may park in the North, East or South.
16. **RVs** are not permitted in the Parking lots. **CAMPING** will be in Westerner Park Campground **ONLY**.

17. Exhibitors will be provided **2** wristbands free of charge for the duration of the event.
18. There will be a **CASH** Machine located in the Lobby of the North Main Entrance.
19. Dogs should be in the building at least one hour prior to ring time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the posted schedule and be at ringside at the time of judging. The club will not call individual dogs to ringside. Please remain at ringside until judging is completed.
20. Dogs in ex-pens and soft sided crates shall be supervised at all times. Soft sided crates are to be placed facing the performance rings.
21. **Crates are prohibited in the conformation ring area. If one is found you will be asked to remove it immediately.**
22. Bathing areas and indoor potty areas are available for exhibitors.

**Exhibitors are reminded to respect hospitality facilities. The Red Deer & District Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse future entries from any exhibitor who creates excessive destructive or disruption to host facilities (hotel, motel or campground).**

**The show Superintendent is in complete charge of the shows and trials which, are governed by CKC rules. No judge or any other person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC rules shall be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show. The Show Committee has a responsibility to see that this rule is enforced.**

***RDDKC has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with RDDKC Shows, including spectators.***



# Rules and Regulations

## **EXCERPTS FROM THE CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations; January 2024**

### **CHAPTER 19.7, Page 64**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

### **CHAPTER 4.7, Page 16, Indignities to a Judge**

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

### **CHAPTER 8.2, Page 24, ENTRIES**

Every dog, including baby puppies, entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) registered with the CKC;
- (b) have an Event Registration Number (ERN);
- (c) have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and must be eligible for registration with the CKC;
- (d) Listed breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

### **CHAPTER 8.3, Page 25, TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)**

**Section 8.3.1** If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- (a) that if born in Canada, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and it is eligible for individual registration;
- (b) that if not born in Canada, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- (c) that if it is foreign-born, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). An Event Registration Number (ERN) or CKC registration number must be obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

#### **Section 8.3.2**

Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

### **CHAPTER 5 – SHOW OFFICIALS**

#### **Section 5.1. 6**

The officials of the show-giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent

Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian, for any reason, shall not compete in any classes or accept any awards for the duration of the shows or trials. No refund of any fees will be issued.

If because of riot, civil disturbance, or any other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be issued.

#### **CHAPTER 11 - UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT**

**Section 11.1** It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person, during the running of or in connection with an event, abuses or harasses a judge, show official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

Any handler who displays unsportsmanlike conduct may be expelled from the show by the RDDKC Show Committee, or any Judge who has observed unsportsmanlike conduct on the part of the handler under the rules in Chapter 11.

#### **CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFYING OR EXCUSING DOGS**

##### **Section 14.1.4**

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. A dog disqualified under Section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement.

Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.



## CLASSES OFFERED

### **CONFORMATION**

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex

#### **REGULAR CLASSES**

**JUNIOR PUPPY** - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY**- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show.

**CANADIAN BRED** - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

**12 – 18 MONTH CLASS** – 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT Allowed.

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**VETERAN CLASS** – In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group, Best Veteran in Show. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

**BABY PUPPY CLASS** – Dogs over 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show.

**BRACE** – This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex).

**EXHIBITION ONLY** – Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

## **OBEDIENCE**

**PRE-NOVICE** – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

**NOVICE “A”** - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under Section No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled

**NOVICE “B”** - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven (7) exercises unless he has two (2) or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

**Novice C** class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six (6) exercises unless he has two (2) or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible

**INTERMEDIATE NOVICE** - as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

**OPEN “A”**- The Open A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD but has not earned the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one (1) dog per handler is allowed in this class and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned an OTCH title may not handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**OPEN “B”** - The Open B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD. Dogs that have earned the title of CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one (1) dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven (7) exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six (6) numbered routines is to be performed. These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six (6) routines so they will be used approximately the same number of times.

**UTILITY "A"** – The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX but has not earned the title of OTCH. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**UTILITY "B"** – The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or OTCH. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one (1) dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six (6) numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six (6) routines so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

## ***RALLY OBEDIENCE***

**RALLY NOVICE A:** Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY NOVICE B:** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY INTERMEDIATE:** The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes. (CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

**RALLY ADVANCED A:** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY ADVANCED B:** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

**RALLY EXCELLENT A:** This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY EXCELLENT B:** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign

**RALLY MASTER:** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE. A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

- 🐾 Rally Ring size will be **45' x 60'**
- 🐾 The precincts of these trials are the ring and immediate surrounding area.
- 🐾 All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- 🐾 No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.
- 🐾 No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C. Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the 'A' class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.
- 🐾 Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

## **UNOFFICIAL RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

\*All dogs entered in the Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only

**BRACE CLASS:** Open to any 2 dogs of any breed and either sex, which has attained the title of R.N. or higher in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person owns both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience Trial. Offered in all Regular Classes

**TEAM CLASS:** The Team Class is open to any 4 dogs of any breed that have earned the title of R.N. or higher. It is not necessary that the same person own all dogs in the team or that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial. Offered in all Regular Classes

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

<b>Dogs Competing*</b>	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
<b>Points Awarded</b>	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

**As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHX) for details.**
