

(Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$57.75 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.)

Junior Handling Number

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

The Application For Junior Handler Number is posted on the CKC website under the Events tab, and then Under Event Forms, Exhibitor, or Event Supplies, Junior Handling. The application can be mailed, faxed, or e-mailed to CKC Head Office and there is no fee.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog *9 months of age and under 12 months of age* on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

<u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards <u>OPEN CLASS</u> - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(if offered by the club, refer to individual Premium List)

<u>NOTE</u>: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day

<u>BRACE CLASS</u> - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show (This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and PRIOR to Best in Show

2 **LIMITED ENTRY** ALL BREED OBEDIENCE TRIALS Ring size (40×60) Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.

The following classes will be offered in each Obedience trial: Pre-novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice intermediate, Veterans, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B. Scores earned by dogs entered in Pre-Novice, Novice C, and Veterans are not eligible for High in Trial.

<u>NOVICE "A"</u> - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE "B" - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

<u>OPEN "A"</u> - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled. The dog must have earned it C.D. Title to enter this class.

<u>OPEN "B"</u>" - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada. The dog must have earned it C.D. title to enter this class.

<u>UTILITY A</u> – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

<u>UTILITY B</u> – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE C – Novice C

For any dog that has earned the title CD, CDX, or UD or any Obedience Trial Championship title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person

<u>INTERMEDIATE NOVICE</u> – Shale be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any Obedience Trial Championship.

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>- This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class". DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY REGULAR CLASS OR EXHIBITION ONLY

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES
ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A
REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY.

Rally Obedience Classes:

2 **LIMITED ENTRY** RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS Ring size (40 x 60)

The following classes will be offered in each trial. Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries. Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B

RALLY NOVICE A:

Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B:

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE:

The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes. (CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A:

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A:

This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D.. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

Refer to Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for further information.
All exhibitors must be familiar with Rally Rules and Regulations effective: January 1, 2015.

The precincts of these trials are the rings and immediate area surrounding the rings of the show site.

Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.
- 4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.
- 5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.
- 11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fore, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will be no paging for individual dogs.
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information, may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number
- (c) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (d) If it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

<u>BORDER CROSSING</u> - A RABIES CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED TO BRING A DOG INTO CANADA, GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE AND IT MUST BE DATED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO CANADA.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE FAMILIAR WITH THE RULES PERTAINING TO THE EVENT IN WHICH THEY ARE COMPETING. THE "DOG SHOW RULES & OBEDIENCE REGULATIONS ARE AVAILABLE FROM:

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The system provides for additional Points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) (3) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

Non Member Participation Fee – (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee.
 Failure to comply within 30 days or notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- This fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of

Canada and is not applicable to CKC members
