Binbrook is a 391-hectare man-made inland lake. It is clean and shallow. Dogs are approximately 30-40 ft out before swimming depth is reached and bottom remains shallow (4-5 ft) at a distance of 100 ft. The lake bottom is silty clay.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment is to be supplied by the entrant.

Be prepared for any weather. This event is entirely outdoors and there is no provision for cover in case of inclement weather.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season may compete, but they will be judged after all other entrants have been tested. An entrant may if desired request a refund, less CKC fees for a bitch that has come into season. A veterinarian's certificate will be required before a refund is processed.

LUNCH

Lunch time will be at the judge's discretion.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Water Rescue Dog Novice and Water Rescue Dog is open to all Newfoundland dogs 6 months of age and over on the day of the test, registered with the CKC. Water Rescue Dog Excellent is open to all Newfoundlands who have previously obtained a NDCC Water Rescue Dog Title.

AWARDS

Through the generosity of its members and friends the Central Ontario Newfoundland Dog Club will offer rosettes for each qualifying score. The CONDC will present a medallion to each dog who successfully acquires a title after receiving three qualifying scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Test Chairperson will be in full charge of the tests.

The CONDC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Owners or handlers are responsible for clean up after their dogs.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing day and time is prohibited.

The CONDC reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules. Telephone entries cannot be accepted except in the case of a postal or disruption.

Confirmation of entry and judging Schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the closing. The Test Secretary may notify entrants via email that their entry has been received.

Entries Positively Close at 8:00p.m. Tuesday August 22, 2023.

QUALIFYING SCORE

To earn a NDCC Water Rescue Dog Novice Title, Water Rescue Dog Title or Water Rescue Dog Excellent Title at these tests the entrant will be required to successfully pass all the exercises as written in the NDCC Water Rescue Dog Test Rules as seen by three qualifying scores by at least two different individual judges.

During the test, the decision of the judges shall be final in all matters affecting the working of dogs and handlers and in the evaluation of their performance.

Re-qualifications may be accepted pending available space. Re-qualifications will be judged last in the level they enter.

POST ENTRIES

Post entries will be accepted for the WRD test from those entrants who have entered the WRDN test. Post entries will be accepted for the WRDX test from those entrants who have had all 3 judges confirm they have qualified for the WRD title at this test. Entries may be limited due to time constraints. Entrants must notify the Test Secretary of their desire to post-enter prior to the commencement of the next level of testing. **An additional entry fee will be charged.**

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

Fee is \$64 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

NONMEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN)

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized or listed breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:

- 1) The dog must be of a CKC recognized or listed breed
- 2) The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- 3) The dog must be spayed or neutered
- 4) The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (this requirement is not necessary for ILP dogs)
- 5) In the case of a foreign-born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC PAL number.
