**Entries:** All entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC form.

Judging Schedule: The order of competing shall generally be the order that entries are received with exception of multiple entries from the same handler, which will be separated whenever possible. Time and entries permitting, dogs that are entered in Introduction to Quarry and Junior Earthdog will be scheduled to run in IQ before JE. A running list will be posted at the site.

Attention Foreign Participants: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American check, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. <u>Do not write 'Payable in Canadian Funds' or 'At Par'</u>. This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or use THE ENTRY LINE. (see box ad above)

# **GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (page 3)**

**Border Crossing:** A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at: <u>http://www.inspection.gc.ca</u>.

**Event Registration Number (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs):** For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering the first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate and the appropriate fee (\$59.40 Canadian Funds) along with a completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca or ordered from the CKC order desk at 1-800-250-8040.

**Regulations:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC **Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations** are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040.

**CKC Regulation 15.7:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Disicipline Committee shal have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

**CKC Regulation 10.5.3 (d):** During the test, the dogs are expected to work together without interference or aggression. The judge may excuse from the test any dog which willfully interferes with its bracemate, either playfully or with malice, or any dog whose behavior is out of control in the opinion of the judge. The judge must dismiss any dog which attacks its bracemate. The judge must report any incident resulting in an excusal or dismissal to the secretary, who shall report such to the CKC. Any dog that has been dismissed twice shall be barred from participation in CKC Earthdog Master tests until reinstated by the CKC. In the case of one dog being excused or dismissed, the remaining dog shall be picked up and run as or with the bye-dog.

# **GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (page 4)**

**Validation of entries:** All participants are required to fill out and sign the Earthdog Participation Agreement on the reverse of the entry form. Entries submitted without this agreement filled out and signed will be refused participation in the tests. Entry Line entries must sign the EPA prior to competing.

**Move-ups:** Move-ups are permissible from IQ to JE one (1) hour before the event or immediately upon completion of IQ level. Move-ups are **NOT** permissible in the regular classes in one test , but are permissible for the next test. (eg: dogs entered for JE for both Sat. & Sun. tests, but completing JE on Sat. may move to SE for the Sun. test) The test secretary must be notified of any move-up one (1) hour before the event.

**Bitches in Season: 6.6.4:** Bitches in season shall **NOT** be eligible to compete in the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Test Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the Test Secretary on or before the date of the Test. Alternatively, the bitch may be presented to a member of the test committee no later than one (1) hour before the scheduled start time to determine that she is in season. The test giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receive flat ribbons. Qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes and an individual prize. In order to be awarded a CKC title Canadian non-CKC members must pay a CKC fee. ("these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members").

**Schedule:** The secretary's table will be open for check in from 7:30am on May 9<sup>th</sup> and May 10<sup>th</sup>. Gate entries will be accepted up to one (1) hour before the scheduled start time of each test.
