As per CKC rules, all dogs entered in Juvenile Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular class at this specialty show at the regular entry fee. Entry from Exhibition Only is not allowed for Juvenile Sweepstakes.

Classes will be divided by sex and age as follows:

6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 - 15 months 15 - 18 months

#### **VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES**

All entrants in sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. A rosette will be awarded to both Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best Veteran of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Classes will be divided by sex and age as follows:

7 - 9 years 9 - 11 years Over 11 years

Prize money for both Sweepstakes will be awarded on the following basis: 20% of the total entry fees will be retained by Clubs to defray costs. The remaining 80% shall be divided as follows:

#### **REGULAR OFFICIAL CLASSIFICATIONS**

You must fill out separate entry forms for EACH EVENT – Conformation or Obedience. (divided by sex)

**Junior Puppy** – a dog between 6 mths and under 9 mths on day of show.

**Senior Puppy** – a dog between 9 mths and under 12 mths on day of show.

12 - 15 Months - a dog between 12 mths and under 15 mths on day of show.

15 - 18 Months - a dog between 15 mths and under 18 mths on day of show.

**Canadian Bred** – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

**Bred By Exhibitor** – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/ co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class - for all dogs.

**Veterans Class** – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. Please note this class is being divided into age categories as follows:

7-9 yrs – for dogs 7yrs & over but less than 9yrs of age 9-11yrs – for dogs 9yrs & over but less than 12yrs of age. 11+ - for dogs 12yrs of age & over.

**<u>\$pecials Only</u>** – dogs who are Canadian Champions only. A CKC registration number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form.

**Exhibition Only** – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**Baby Puppy**: Dogs 3 mths of age and under 6 mths of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

**Brace**: Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

**<u>\$tud Dog & Get:</u>** Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog and Get must also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only. Stud Dog may be neutered.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny**: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch and all Progeny must also be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

**<u>Field Dog</u>**: For those dogs that have attained a Working title or Gun Dog title (AKC or CKC) or have received a qualifying leg towards title.

**<u>Gun Dog</u>**: For those dogs that have attained a Gun Dog title (AKC or CKC) or have received a qualifying leg towards title.

CKC Requirements - It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)

No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)

#### **OBEDIENCE**

### Regular Obedience Classes CLASSIFICATION — OBEDIENCE

**NOVICE A** - The Novice A Class shall be for any English Springer Spaniel which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under section No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**NOVICE B** - The Novice B Class shall be for any English Springer Spaniel dog which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B Class at any one trial.

PRE-NOVICE - for any English Springe Spaniel which has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one do in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in group exercise. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US. The Pre Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to Novice Classes. The CKC will permit the use of PCD signifying Pre Companion Dog to be used in connection with and after the name of the dog. In order to receive this title dogs must receive passing scores in three different trials under two different judges.

**OPEN A** - The Open A Class shall be for English Springer Spaniel which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X.. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned its C.D.X. title is not eligible for entry in this class but may be entered in the Open B Class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score gwarded will be cancelled.

**OPEN B** - The Open B Class shall be for any English Springe Spaniel which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. must enter in the Open B Class. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Open A and Open B classes at any one trial. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Open Class B at the same trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times.

**UTILITY A** - The Utility A Class shall be for any English Springer Spaniel which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**UTILITY B** - The Utility B Class shall be for any English Springer Spaniel which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at the ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

#### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. #### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

There will be no prong or spike collars or flexi leads permitted at this venue. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. There will be no excessive training or playing within 30 feet of the obedience ring.

All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. (Please type or print clearly.)

Incomplete entries will be returned. Agent and handlers please note that full name and address of owners MUST be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show/trials secretary after the closing time and date.

Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter these shows. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.

A copy of the rules pertaining to dog shows and or Obedience Trials is available from the CKC (1-416-675-5511). It is the exhibitors responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

The ESSCC / HKC will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

The welfare of an exhibitors child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over there children while they are on the show premises.

The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows and Trials.

Double handling will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the show premises.

The building will close one and one half hour after the completion of daily judging.

Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be allowed in the building.

Puppy for Sale & Dogs for Sale signs will not be permitted in the building.

The ESSCC & HKC will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.

BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
