

Nov 13th, 2023 Indoor CKC Agility Trial Judging Schedule

Thank you for supporting our trial. If you have not already done so, please review your entry for classes and jump heights and notify the trial secretary at dlmagility@gmail.com as soon as possible of any concerns. We will be using RING 5 for these trials.

You will get course maps at the registration desk where you will be checking in and selecting your volunteer positions. Course maps will be provided AFTER the novice warm up run. Barb, our volunteer coordinator will be there to assist you. Your entry was dependant on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

You MUST have indoor shoes when you are in the Red Barn.

PARKING and CRATING: Parking is available in the main parking lot as well as on east and west side of Red Barn. You may NOT park along the laneway under the trees.

There is crating available in the Red Barn on a first come basis. The area on the SOUTH side of the ring is for <u>quiet dogs only</u>. If your dog barks or whines while you are helping in the ring, please crate in EAST crating area outside of rubber area. Competitors may crate from their car but we will not have anyone calling out for dogs in the parking lot so if you are crating there you are responsible for being at the ring on time.

NEW

We are excited to be trying the <u>Agility Gate</u> program, this program will allow you to follow the running order and the progress of the trial from your phone! Go to the app store or google play to download the program onto your phone or mobile device (can be IOS or android). You need to do this before the trial as the mobile data can not support everyone downloading at the same time.

When you arrive at the trial, we will have a code for you to use. Open Agility Gate go to menu bar and choose our trial (Nov 13 2023 CKC SPD trial) and go to the classes you entered and find your dog's name and swipe it left to right and click on the purple box, your dog's name will be changed to purple (this will let the gate steward and all other competitors know you are checked in. If you decide to change to FFO click on the green, if you decide to scratch click on the red. You will then be able to watch how the trial is progressing as the ring steward will be marking their tablet when the dog runs and the dog will be crossed off. Please remember if you are running FFO (booked as FFO or changed to FFO) you MUST announce it as you enter the ring, this is a CKC regulation.

As we are all new to this we will be also checking in on paper and have paper gate sheets but we hope to be able to eliminate this and save trees. If anyone has used agility gate before, please let us know as you will be a great resource, please volunteer to help!

The Red Barn property will be opened at 7:00 am. Please note day of trial entries will NOT be accepted at this trial.

Running order for the day is: Running Tall to small

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEING ON SITE AND READY FOR YOUR RUNS.

Please note we will start the next class when the course is finished building all times below are approximate times and we hope to finish early.

Novice warm up run walk through will be 7:45 a.m.

Novice warm up first dog on the line 8:00 a.m. Novice Warm up run (open to dogs entered in Novice Standard payment in cash only (please help us with exact change, \$10) Please sign up and pay at registration desk.

Official trial will start immediately after the warm up run.

Intermediate Standard Run (14 dogs)

Excellent, Master Excellent Standard Run (14 dogs)

Jumps and Tunnels (50 dogs)

Novice Jumpers with Weaves I (26 dogs)

Novice Jumpers with Weaves II (24 dogs)

Intermediate Jumpers with Weaves I (11 dogs)

Intermediate Jumpers with Weaves II (10 dogs)

Excellent/Master, Excellent Jumpers with Weaves I (10 dogs)


Excellent/Master, Excellent Jumpers with Weaves II (10 dogs)

Please note the judge will take a break for lunch at her discretion.

RESULTS & RIBBONS:

You will find the results posted on tables by the crating area. Your qualifying ribbon and placement ribbons are there. If you do not wish to take them that is okay, we will be able to reuse them. Congrats to those of you who achieved a new title and wish to get a new title ribbon. Please go to Barb at check in and purchase your new title ribbon for \$10 (please exact change only). Please send us a picture so we can post it on our social media ③ You will also receive an email of your results. Results will also be posted on The Red Barn Event Centre website.

We will have a leash runner. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash (this is a CKC regulation). There cannot be food or toys (non-squeaky toys are allowed in FFO runs) within 10 ft of the ring (this is a CKC regulation).



CKC FINE PRINT:

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting, the Tracking fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion. Non-Member Participation Fee a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either, to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member Participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non- CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$63.90 + HST.

CKC HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- Only Park in the designated parking area.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
- Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum
- Be nice to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect give others the same respect. We have a zero tolerance for any abuse of dogs or humans.
- Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends.
