A Prize and Rosette will be offered for the following placements:

BEST OF BREED BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX BEST OF WINNERS BEST PUPPY IN BREED WINNERS MALE RESERVE WINNERS MALE WINNERS FEMALE RESERVE WINNERS FEMALE SELECT MALE SELECT FEMALE BABY PUPPY STUD DOG BROOD BITCH BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR (must come from Bred By Exhibitor classes) BEST VETERAN IN BREED (must come from the Veteran classes)

#### **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. 25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows: First in each class - 50% of entry fee for that class. Rosette and 15% for Best in Sweepstakes. Rosette and 10% for Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes

All dogs in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes at this Specialty EXCEPT for puppies aged 4-6 months. These puppies may enter from the Baby Puppy Class or from the Exhibition (4-6 mos.) Class.

The following classes will be offered (divided by sex): 4-6 months 6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

### **CLASSIFICATION**

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

BABY PUPPY dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show (unofficial) JUNIOR PUPPY dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show SENIOR PUPPY dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show 12-18 MONTHS dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show CANADIAN BRED dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded. BRED BY EXHIBITOR dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

EXHIBITION ONLY dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 MONTHS) puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4- 6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female:

### **NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES**

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

STUD DOG & GET Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

CUT DOWN Dogs entered in the Cut Down class must be entered as Exhibition Only.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

On the day of the show/trial, the show/trial superintendent will be in complete charge of the show/trial.

Only dogs properly entered in the show/trial will be admitted.

Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging. Dogs must not be left in the building overnight.

Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward. The show/trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs or patrons.

If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show/trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.

The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. The Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. The show/trial grounds are defined as the confines of the St. John's Rec Center, St. John's, NL. The authorities of the shows/trials may decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show/trial building. No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: a Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;

b Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);

c Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Taylor is Canada's Top winning Toy Dog of all times, we also had the privilege of Breeding Canada's #1 Dog of All Breed's for 2011 as well as several other Top 10 Of All Breeds throughout the years.



## SWEEPSTAKES JUDGE

Faye has shown and judged many different breeds over the last 40 years in both Canada and the US. In 1981 Faye bred her first litter of English Springer Spaniels, this litter produced the first of many BIS winning dogs. In 1992 on her first trip to the Montgomery County Terrier show in Pennsylvania, she acquired her first of many top winning West Highland White Terriers, finishing Championships & Grand Championships in Canada, the US and Bermuda.In 2005 a good friend offered her a Brussels Griffon and today Dashwood Kennels are still producing BISS and BIS winning dogs of both breeds.
