#### JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

This event is open to all dogs 6 months of age and under 18 months on the day of this event. All dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes on the day of the Specialty.

CLASSES: For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

6 months & under 9 months Males/Females 9 months & under 12 months Males/Females

12 months & under 18 months Males/Females

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Sweepstakes

## **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 to 10 years Male/Female, 10 years and over Male/Female

All dogs MUST be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only on the day of this Specialty. Spayed or neutered veterans may compete provided they are also entered in the Veterans (competitive) regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. All dogs <u>**MUST**</u> be entered in the Altered class or for Exhibition Only.

This Sweepstakes event will be divided by sex as follows:

### Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be will then compete for the awards of Best Altered in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex Altered in Sweepstakes.



#### Heritage Park @ Lickman Road

East from Vancouver, Hwy 1 take exit 116 (Lickman Road) West from Hope/Interior/Alberta, Hwy 1 take exit 116 (Lickman Road) From the United States, take either, Lynden or Sumas Border crossing, to Hwy 1 and then east of Hwy 1 to Exit 116 (Lickman Road) Heritage Park is on the South side of the freeway.

### CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

The following official regular/non-regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided JUNIOR PUPPY - dogs 6 months & under 9 months on day of this Show SENIOR PUPPY - dogs 9 months & under 12 months on day of this Show 12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - dogs 12 mths & under 18 mths on day of Show CANADIAN BRED - dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded BRED BY EXHIBITOR - For dogs owned and handled in the ring by Breeder **OPEN CLASS** - For all dogs (Note: Divided by colour)

**SPECIALS ONLY** - For dogs that have earned all the Championship Points required for CKC Championship status at the time of closing of entries VETERANS CLASS - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition. (Note: Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in this class)

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES

#### ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ONE OF THE REGULAR CLASSES OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

EXHIBITION ONLY: All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list.

STUD DOG CLASS - This class shall be comprised of the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get. All dogs comprising the get need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Get must be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - This class shall be comprised of the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her progeny. All dogs comprising the progeny need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.

# SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

### **Altered Male or Altered Female**

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed



Reserved grooming - again, offered at NO CHARGE! Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Individuals, or groups of individuals with a minimum of 6 dogs may request space. This will be on a first come, first served basis. If you are coming with a large number of dogs, PLEASE request grooming in advance, rather than expecting to be accommodated at the last minute!!

Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first serve and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be <u>NO</u> exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left in DAY OF SHOW grooming after Best in Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates. Please note: Exercise pens in all areas except Day of Show Grooming (no pens permitted in this area) **may** be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

Specialty clubs will be given a 10' x 15' UPON request. This can be increased depending on the breed and number of entries. Please make your request as soon as possible.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted, may be asked to leave the show. Renaissance is pleased to provide the reserved grooming at no charge to the exhibitors
