



THE PRECINCTS OF THESE TRIALS WILL BE THE RCMP BUILDING

RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

The Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club will use all responsible care to ensure the safety of the dogs exhibited but will not be responsible for or assume liability for loss or injury to any dog or exhibitor. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry will be made.

Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on leash at all times within the building and Fairgrounds with the exception of the obedience ring. No dogs will be allowed inside the RCMP building during these trials unless officially entered with the exception of the Certified Assistance Dogs.

The Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club reserves the right to remove any person from these trials. The Trials Chairperson and Superintendent shall have full control of the event which will be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club rules.

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct and actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds. Please pick up after your dogs both inside and outside the building.

Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event Number; eligible for registration with the CKC; or, have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed (Sec 6.1.1)

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called. (Sec 8.6.2)

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during these trials.

Any dog entered and received at an obedience trial must compete in all exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, or the trial chair. (Sec 6.4.1)

Bitches in Season may not compete. Full refunds will be given for dogs withdrawn because of injury, illness or death and for bitches in season, if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will have the CKC event fees and listing fees, if applicable, deducted.

Any person either within or outside the judging ring who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise affect in any way, the attention, deportment or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the discipline committee in whatever way it considers in the best interests of GVDOTC, or the judge may take summary action.

Entry forms must be complete in every respect. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dog.

The Club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee, or authorized agent. (Sec 6.2.2)

The entry of a dog must be accompanied by the entry fees. (Sec 6.3.2) Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post dated cheques will not be accepted.

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Sec 6.3.3)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Trials Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Sec 19.7)

Exhibitors should be familiar with the current Jan $1^{\rm st}$ 2008 Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trials Rules and Regulations and the Jan $1^{\rm st}$ 2011 Rally Trials Rules and Regulations.

RALLY NOVICE A THIS CLASS SHALL BE FOR DOGS THAT HAVE NOT WON THE RALLY NOVICE (R. N.) TITLE OR ANY CKC NOVICE OBEDIENCE TITLE. NO HANDLER WHO HAS EXHIBITED A DOG THROUGH ITS CKC CDX (COMPANION DOG EXCELLENT) TITLE OR INSTRUCTED DOG TRAINING CLASSES SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THIS CLASS. THE HANDLER OF ANY DOG IN THIS CLASS MUST BE THE OWNER, CO-OWNER, OR A MEMBER OF THEIR IMMEDIATE FAMILIES. A PERSON MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE DOG IN THIS CLASS. A DOG MAY CONTINUE TO COMPETE IN THIS CLASS AFTER THE OWNER HAS BEEN NOTIFIED BY AT LEAST 2 DIFFERENT JUDGES THAT THE DOG HAS WON 3 QUALIFYING SCORES IN THIS CLASS. RALLY NOVICE B ANY DOG MAY COMPETE IN THIS CLASS UNTIL A QUALIFYING SCORE IN THE RALLY ADVANCED CLASS IS EARNED. THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON MAY HANDLE DOGS IN THIS CLASS. A PERSON MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE DOG IN THIS CLASS. NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH RALLY NOVICE A AND RALLY NOVICE B AT ANY ONE TRIAL

RALLY ADVANCED A THIS CLASS SHALL BE FOR DOGS THAT HAVE WON THE RALLY NOVICE (R. N.) TITLE BUT HAVE NOT WON THE RALLY ADVANCED (R. A.) TITLE OR ANY CKC NOVICE OBEDIENCE TITLE. NO HANDLER WHO HAS EXHIBITED A DOG THROUGH ITS CKC CDX (COMPANION DOG EXCELLENT) TITLE OR INSTRUCTED DOG TRAINING CLASSES SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THIS CLASS. THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON MAY HANDLE DOGS IN THIS CLASS. A PERSON MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE DOG IN THIS CLASS. NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH RALLY ADVANCED A AND RALLY ADVANCED B AT ANY ONE TRIAL

RALLY EXCELLENT A THIS CLASS SHALL BE FOR DOGS THAT HAVE WON THE RALLY ADVANCED (R. A.) TITLE, BUT HAVE NOT WON THE RALLY EXCELLENT (R. E.) TITLE OR ANY CKC NOVICE OBEDIENCE TITLE. NO HANDLER WHO HAS EXHIBITED A DOG THROUGH ITS CKC CDX (COMPANION DOG EXCELLENT) TITLE OR INSTRUCTED DOG TRAINING CLASSES SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THIS CLASS. THE HANDLER OF ANY DOG IN THIS CLASS MUST BE THE OWNER, CO-OWNER, OR A MEMBER OF THEIR IMMEDIATE FAMILIES. A PERSON MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE DOG IN THIS CLASS. THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON MAY HANDLE DOGS IN THIS CLASS. A PERSON MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE DOG IN THIS CLASS. NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH RALLY EXCELLENT A AND RALLY EXCELLENT B AT ANY ONE TRIAL

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011

- A) AN ANNUAL NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE FOR AWARDS AND TITLES WILL BE CHARGED TO A CANADIAN NON-MEMBER OF CKC. THE FEE WILL MATCH THE ERN FEE.
- B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- C) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

BORDER CROSSING

CANADIAN GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE THAT A DOG ENTERING INTO CANADA MUST HAVE A VALID RABIES CERTIFICATE. THE RABIES CERTIFICATE MUST BE DATED 30 DAYS PRIOR TO RE-ENTRY INTO THE UNITED STATES.

JUDGING SCHEDULES

Judging of the Rally Obedience Trials on Saturday May 28^{th} will begin with Trial 1 in the morning, and Trial 2 will follow in the afternoon. On Sunday May 29^{th} , Trial 3 will be judged in the morning, and Trial 4 will follow in the afternoon.

Judging of all regular Obedience classes will begin at 9am on both Saturday and Sunday May $28^{\rm th}$ & $29^{\rm th}$ 2011.

DETAILED JUDGING SCHEDULES WILL BE SENT TO ENTRANTS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE BY EMAIL WHEN POSSIBLE.

MOVE UPS

A DOG THAT IS REGISTERED IN THE RECORDS OF THE CKC OR HAS A PEN, AN ERN, OR AN MCN AND HAS FULFILLED THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A TITLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CKC OBEDIENCE OR RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES, MAY BE MOVED TO THE NEXT LEVEL OF COMPETITION. THE TRANSFER MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY ON THE APPROPRIATE MOVE UP FORM BY THE OWNER OR HANDLER ONE HOUR BEFORE THE OPENING OF THE FIRST TRIAL ON THAT DAY, SCHEDULE PERMITTING.

REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NOVICE A: For dogs which have not won a CD (Companion Dog) title in any country. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any one dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No professional handler or trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class any score awarded will be cancelled and any trophies must be returned.

NOVICE B: For dogs which have not won a CD title in Canada. Dogs may be handled or exhibited by owner or any other person. If handlers are exhibiting more than one dog, additional handlers must be provided for the sit and down exercises.

OPEN A: For dogs which have won the CD title in Canada, but have not yet won the CDX title (Companion Dog EXCELLENT). Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any one dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No professional handler or trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class any score awarded will be cancelled and any trophies must be returned.

OPEN B: For dogs which have won the CD title in Canada. A dog may continue to compete in this class after winning the CDX title and/or Utility. If handlers are exhibiting more than one dog, additional handlers must be provided for the sit and down exercises.

UTILITY: FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE WON THE CDX TITLE IN CANADA. A DOG MAY CONTINUE TO COMPETE IN THIS CLASS AFTER WINNING THE UD (UTILITY DOG) TITLE.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

VETERANS: SHALL BE FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE AN OBEDIENCE TITLE AND ARE 7 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER ON MAY 29TH 2011. THE EXERCISES WILL BE PERFORMED AND JUDGED AS IN THE NOVICE CLASS AS SET OUT IN THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB'S OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS. DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY ALSO BE ENTERED IN ANY REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY. IN THE VETERANS CLASS, 1 (ONE) POINT WILL BE AWARDED TO THE OBEDIENCE SCORE FOR EVERY 6 MONTHS OF AGE THAT THE EXHIBITING DOG IS OVER 7 YEARS OF AGE

GRADUATE NOVICE: IS OPEN TO ANY DOG THAT HAS NOT GAINED A QUALIFYING SCORE TOWARDS A CDX TITLE IN CANADA, BUT WHICH HAS OBTAINED THE TITLE OF CD IN CANADA PRIOR TO THE CLOSING DATE OF THESE TRIALS. EXHIBITORS MAY ENTER MORE THAN 1 DOG IN THIS CLASS, BUT MUST HAVE A SEPARATE HANDLER FOR EACH DOG IN THE LONG SIT AND DOWN EXERCISES WHEN THEY ARE JUDGED IN THE SAME GROUP. THE GRADUATE NOVICE EXERCISES WILL BE PERFORMED AND JUDGED AS IN THE OFFICIAL NOVICE AND OPEN CLASSES AS SET OUT IN THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB'S OBBDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

VERSATILITY: IS OPEN TO ANY DOG THAT HAS ATTAINED THE TITLE OF CDX IN CANADA AND AT LEAST ONE LEG ON THE UTILITY TITLE, OR THAT HAS OBTAINED THE TITLE OF UD IN CANADA PRIOR TO THE CLOSING DATE OF THESE TRIALS. THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON MAY HANDLE DOGS IN THIS CLASS. OWNERS MAY ENTER MORE THAN 1 DOG IN THIS CLASS. THE VERSATILITY EXERCISES WILL BE PERFORMED AND JUDGED AS IN THE OFFICIAL NOVICE, OPEN AND UTILITY CLASSES AS SET OUT IN THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB'S OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

BRACE: IS OPEN TO ANY 2 DOGS OF ANY BREED AND OF EITHER SEX THAT HAS ATTAINED NOT LESS THAN A CD TITLE IN CANADA. THE BRACE CLASS IS PERFORMED AND JUDGED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE NOVICE CLASS AS SET OUT IN THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB'S OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS. THE 2 DOGS SHALL BE HITCHED TOGETHER WITH A BRACE CHAIN OR COUPLING. EXHIBITORS MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE BRACE IN THIS CLASS, BUT MUST HAVE A SEPARATE HANDLER FOR EACH BRACE IN THE LONG SIT AND DOWN EXERCISES WHEN JUDGED IN THE SAME GROUP. AN ENTRY FORM FOR EACH DOG ON THE BRACE TEAM IS REQUIRED ALONG WITH THE NAME OF THE OTHER BRACE MEMBER ATTACHED TO EACH ENTRY.

TEAM: IS OPEN TO ANY 4 DOGS OF ANY BREED WHICH HAVE ATTAINED NOT LESS THAN A CD TITLE IN CANADA. IT IS NOT NECESSARY THAT THE SAME PERSON OWN ALL DOGS IN THE TEAM. FIVE DOGS MAY BE ENTERED, ONE TO BE CONSIDERED AS AN ALTERNATE. HOWEVER, THE SAME 4 DOGS MUST COMPETE IN ALL EXERCISES. THE EXERCISES WILL BE PERFORMED SIMULTANEOUSLY AND JUDGED EXACTLY AS SPECIFIED FOR THE NOVICE AND OPEN CLASSES AS SET OUT IN THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB'S OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS. AN ENTRY FORM FOR EACH DOG ON THE TEAM IS REQUIRED ALONG WITH A LIST OF THE OTHER TEAM MEMBERS ATTACHED TO EACH ENTRY

RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

The Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club will use all responsible care to ensure the safety of the dogs exhibited but will not be responsible for or assume liability for loss or injury to any dog or exhibitor. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry will be made.

Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on leash at all times within the building and Fairgrounds with the exception of the obedience ring. No dogs will be allowed inside the RCMP building during these trials unless officially entered with the exception of the Certified Assistance Dogs.

The Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club reserves the right to remove any person from these trials. The Trials Chairperson and Superintendent shall have full control of the event which will be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club rules.

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct and actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds. Please pick up after your dogs both inside and outside the building.

Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration or Performance Event Number; eligible for registration with the CKC; or, have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed (Sec 6.1.1)

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called. (Sec 8.6.2)

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during these trials.

Any dog entered and received at an obedience trial must compete in all exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, or the trial chair. (Sec 6.4.1)

Bitches in Season may not compete. Full refunds will be given for dogs withdrawn because of injury, illness or death and for bitches in season, if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will have the CKC event fees and listing fees, if applicable, deducted.

Any person either within or outside the judging ring who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise affect in any way, the attention, deportment or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the discipline committee in whatever way it considers in the best interests of GVDOTC, or the judge may take summary action.

Entry forms must be complete in every respect. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dog.

The Club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee, or authorized agent. (Sec 6.2.2)

The entry of a dog must be accompanied by the entry fees. (Sec 6.3.2) Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post dated cheques will not be accepted.

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (Sec 6.3.3)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Trials Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Sec 19.7)

Exhibitors should be familiar with the current Jan $1^{\rm st}$ 2008 Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trials Rules and Regulations and the Jan $1^{\rm st}$ 2011 Rally Trials Rules and Regulations.






