**February 13 & 14, 2021**

All Province of Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) COVID-19 Regulations will be followed.

These rules and SKOC Regulations are subject to change depending on SHA Regulations.

PLEASE do not attend these trials if you are exhibiting any irregular signs of illness.

- **MASKS ARE MANDATORY** in all areas of the Trial Precinct which is defined as building and parking lot.
- **NO SPECTATORS**
- **ONLY** handlers entered in the specific class being judged will be allowed into the building and we ask that you space yourselves at least 10ft apart while waiting your turn.
- Temporary benching spots for dog/crate during classes will be provided and we kindly ask that you vacate in a timely manner to make space for Exhibitors in subsequent classes.
- Reserved benching space for kennels has been provided to assist multi-entry handlers to avoid the need to move crates in and out of building. When there is more than 30 minutes between these dog entries, we ask that handler vacate building (no spectators) until called in for next class.
- Large classes may be broken up into smaller groups to enter building for Individual Exercises and Qualifying teams will remain in building until Group Exercises are completed. We kindly ask competitors that do not Qualify in Individual Exercises to exit building in a timely manner to accommodate space needed for teams that follow in your class.
- Entrants are asked to drop off waivers when entering building for first trial.
- SKOC would appreciate if Dog # and text # would be made available to our Door Steward so we may message when it is time for you to get ready for your class.
- There will be no Canteen services provided. Handlers are asked to keep all food in their vehicles. We do understand the need for beverages for multi-dog handlers. Treats and water for dogs are welcome. We ask that all recyclable containers are removed by the handler and garbage is placed in bins that will be provided by the front door.
- Catalogues will be provided by Email ONLY
- No Exhibition Only will be accepted

Any handler unable to attend these trials due to exhibiting COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, after entries close, will receive a credit to any future CKC events hosted by the SKOC. Credits will expire after one year. Entries from this trial will be considered equal value to the credit towards future trial(s).

### COVID-19 CKC OBEDIENCE TRIAL Allowable Changes

- Handler will place their leash, dumbbells etc. in a designated spot and pick up after their run. The ring steward will NOT bring your leash to you. Your dog must leave the ring on-leash and under control.
- Utility handlers please bring tongs as you may be required to handle your own articles.
- Qualifying Rosettes, ribbons and score sheets will be left on a table for handlers to pick up if they wish at end of their class. No ribbon/rosette presentations in the ring.
- Special prizes will be verified by Trial Chair or Event Secretary and will be placed out at time of award in specified location.
- There will be no printed catalogues. Electronic Copies may be provided by email.
- Posts will be used for Figure 8 posts at all levels
- Group Stays – dogs will be placed a minimum of 10ft apart for all levels, inside and outside of the ring. A dog that fails to qualify in the Individual Exercises will not be eligible to compete in the Group Exercise.
- NOTE – Jump Heights for dogs will be according to their correct height at the withers or for accepted veteran heights. There will be no reduced heights incorporated into these trials.
