**FCRSC Club Rules for these events:**

1. Post Entries will be accepted for all entered dogs meeting requirements
2. A dog may only be entered in 1 test not both
3. To prevent judge overloads you may be asked to enter the other test

**Order of running:**

The order of the stakes for each Test (Land, Water) will be decided after entries are closed.

Both WC Tests will run First followed by both WCI and then both WCX.

**General Information:**

- Bitches in season will not be eligible to compete and are not allowed on the test grounds. Fees refunded with a veterinary certificate confirming the bitch is in heat.
- Ducks will be used.
- No training is allowed on the testing grounds.
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used
- Handlers should not wear distinctive white or light clothing except that handlers may wear handling jackets for blinds in WCX.
- Test Grounds: Please no littering. Please pick up after your dog. No smoking. Dogs should be on lead unless running the test.
- Printed catalogues will not be provided. In advance of the test, the catalogue will be made available for download along with a running order.

**Nova Scotia Duck Tollers:** Will receive a suitable prize for all qualifiers

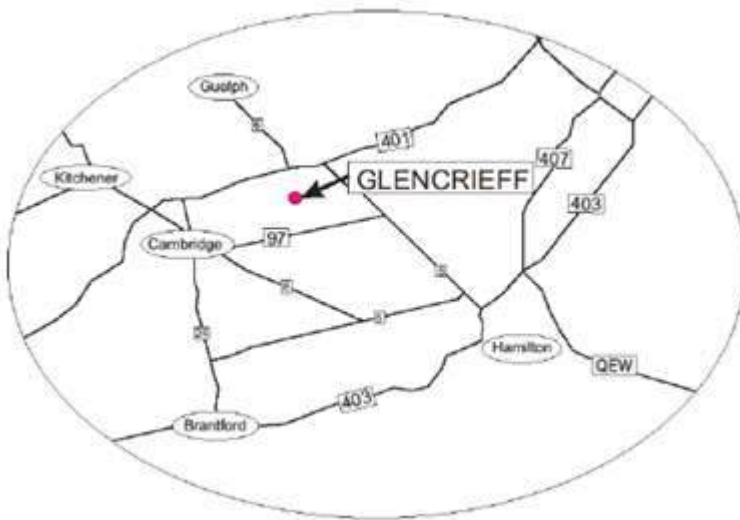
**Golden Retrievers:** Will receive a suitable prize for all qualifiers
