#### **ERN NOTICE**

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and who enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number. The ERN (Event Registration Number) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes, but rather enables a foreign-owned or foreign-born dog to be awarded titles for the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or FAX a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. The cost is \$59.40. Dogs may initially be entered as "listed", but the ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. ## 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

## **FOREIGN EXHIBITORS**

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to the consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted and must be payable in Canadian funds. If a cheque is sent in US funds, it must be made out for the full required fees, and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds", or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. ## **CLASSIFICATIONS**

The following official CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of the show
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of the show
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of the show
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	For dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes/parades
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	For puppies 3-6 months of age provided the owner(s) has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Official Class. These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or parades (this is a catalogue listing only)

The following Non-Regular classes will be provided (all dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following classes. Dogs may be spayed/neutered):

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair.  Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
SIRE & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Ownership need not be identical. Stud may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get MUST be entered in a Regular class.
DAM & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog class.
FIELD TRIAL CLASS	Open to all field champions of record (CKC, AKC, AFSA). Must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only.

## **SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES**

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the altered class judging.

Two classes ONLY will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best of Opposite Sex Altered.

#### JUNIOR HANDLING

This competition will be offered after the Specialty. Any dog entered in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only in the specialty. The dog need not be owned by the junior handler or any of his immediate family. Classes will be: Pee Wee, Junior Novice, Junior Open, Intermediate Novice, Intermediate Open, Senior Novice and Senior Open. Juniors may enter at any time prior to the start of the Specialty. There will be a fee of \$2.00. Judge to be announced at the show.

## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20 - Dog Show Rules: Champions and Championship Points.

Section 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a Conformation show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of Championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Section 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

All dogs defeated, either directly or indirectly up to the Breed level, are to be including in the count. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Dog Show Rule books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy plus GST.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will have full control of the Specialty Show, which shall be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. A judge officiating at a show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 4. Any dog excused by the Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 5. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs & exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any Liability in the event of accident or misfortune to dog or exhibitor regardless of cause.
- 6. It is expected that anyone participating in this show will be familiar the CKC rules pertaining to such an event. If you have any questions, a CKC Conformation Rule Book is available for viewing at the Show Secretary's table.
- 7. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors and/or handlers to have dogs at ringside when required for judging. Handlers are to report any absentees, and to have assistants at ringside if they have more than one dog entered and might be engaged elsewhere.
- 8. Entries will be acknowledged by email as soon as possible after the closing date.
- 9. All dogs must be kept under control at all times.
- 10. Entries withdrawn in writing before the closing date and time will receive a full refund of entry fees. Entry fees shall not be refunded in whole or part after the closing date and time. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Judge, Show Superintendent or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been incorrectly entered, no refund will be made.
- 11. All dogs not individually registered in the records of the CKC must pay listing fees.
