Courses will be reversed for PM event. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS: Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed-breed.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. Running order determined by order in which entries are received. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. To earn a Pass a dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

300 YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. Dogs will run one loop.

600 YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. Dogs will run both loops.

RIBBONS AND TITLES:

Gold qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs passing their test. There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program. They are:

Chase Ability (CA) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges.

Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of ten times (CA + 7 additional passes)

Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2) awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

• Dogs will be run once.

• Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.

- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last test.
- There will be a canteen for your eating pleasure.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- A veterinary clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Please come early to help fill gopher holes as they have been very busy.

In consideration of acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or prizes at the Chase Ability events to be held on June 11&12, 2016, I agree:

1. To hold the Foothills Gazehound Club including their members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as the "FGC"), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;

2. To hold the FGC harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the FGC or any other person(s);

3. Assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the FGC harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liability imposed by law upon the FGC for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the FGC or any other person(s);

Non Member Participation Fee

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, CKC will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$56.70. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.



From the North:

QE Hwy #2 South To Stoney Trail Exit 271. Take Eastbound Stoney Trail to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy 22X East to Hwy #24 (4-way stop). Turn Right and go to 2.4 km south on Hwy #24 Wet Noses will be on the right just before you cross the canal. Along with the large Wet Noses Sign visible in the driveway from Hwy #24, there is a 25 foot Canadian Flag as well as a Wet Noses flag just before the canal bridge. The road into the facility is about 1 km long. Please drive slowly and take caution if passing, as shoulders are steep.

From the South:

QE Hwy #2 North to Stoney Trail Exit 234A. Exit East (right) on Stoney Trail to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X Exit East and follow directions from North. The road into the facility is about 1 km long. Please drive slowly and take caution if passing, as shoulders are steep.

From the West:

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Stoney Trail (Hwy #201). Follow Stoney Trail to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X Exit East and follow directions from North. The road into the facility is about 1 km long. Please drive slowly and take caution if passing, as shoulders are steep.

From the East:

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #24 (Highway to Lethbridge). South (left) on Hwy #24 to Hwy 22X (4-Way Stop) Continue South on Hwy #24 for 2.4 kms. Facility entry is on the right just before the canal bridge. Along with the large Wet Noses Sign visible in the driveway from Hwy #24, there is a 25 foot Canadian Flag as well as a Wet Noses flag. The road into the facility is about 1 km long. Please drive slowly and take caution if passing, as shoulders are steep.
