AWARDS

Flat ribbons will be provided for all qualifying scores.
Rosettes will be provided for all High in Class (except Pre-Novice).
Rosette and Certificate will be provided for High in Trial.
New title rosettes will be offered.

NOTICE LIMITED ENTRIES

Entry in the obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned to more than 7 hours of judging. Total time allotted for judging at Trial 1 & 2 will be 3 hours each. Once a judge has reached their capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. There will be no waitlist maintained for this sanction match.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund entry fees.

ENTRY FEES

Each entry per dog per trial.....	\$30.00
TCN Fee per dog (per trial for dog with no individual CKC No.).....	\$11.30
Dogs entered For Exhibition Only.....	\$10.00

All fees include HST and are in Canadian funds. A TCN fee is payable for all dogs entered at trials who do not have an individual CKC registration number, an ERN, a CCN, or a PEN. A TCN number must be obtained for these dogs. This can be done online at www.ckc.ca. Dogs entered For Exhibition Only (FEO) will not be granted access to the ring to compete or practice; FEO is to allow a non-competing dog to be on competition grounds only.

Refunds prior to closing date will be issued by cheque to the name and address listed in the entry form. No refunds will be offered for withdrawals after closing date, with the exception of bitches in season.

NO entries will be accepted on the day of the trial.

Before You Enter An Obedience "A" Class!

Novice A

Section 10.1.4 No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Open HA and Open 18A

Section 12.2.4 Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned an OTCH title may not handle a dog in these classes.

Utility A

13.1.2 Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full, including waiver form.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to notify exhibitor that their entry form has been received. No other confirmation will be sent to exhibitors unless an error requires clarification, or if payment has not been received by closing date.
3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
4. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, with the exception of pulling bitches in season as stated in this premium list.
5. Only dogs that are registered with the Canadian Kennel Club or are eligible to be registered (TCN) can be entered.
6. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. Judging schedules will be sent out as soon as possible after entries close, and no later than six (6) days prior to trial starting. Armbands will be provided upon arrival.
8. Indoor crating area will be provided for exhibitors, but space is limited – please do not bring dogs that are not entered in the trial.
9. Indoor washroom facilities are provided on site. There is no lunch provided.
10. Move-ups are allowed per Section 6.9.1 of the Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Rules & Regulations.
11. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the management rendering it impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 20.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: it shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it seems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

MASTER OBEDIENCE TRIAL CHAMPION (MOTCH)

Section 14.3.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 14.3.2 Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.

Section 14.3.3 Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits towards both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.

Section 14.3.4 One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.

Section 14.3.5 A dog must acquire a title of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.
