Timer: Times the dogs' runs using electronic timing

Course Builder: Assists the Chief Course Builder with putting obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge

Are you in the correct Agility Class? (please note changes)

Selected Class: Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Selected and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one jump height lower then its Regular jump height and get 10% more time then the STC.

Novice is for dogs that have never acquired a CKC agility title in that class. Dogs may continue to compete in Novice once they have acquired that title, but must be moved up once they have a leg in Intermediate in that class.

Excellent is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

Master Excellent (formerly Excellent B) is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Master Excellent in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in. A dog only needs to be entered in Master Excellent for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. ie. A dog can be in Excellent JWW and Master Excellent Standard.

Veteran Class: a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one or two jump heights lower then its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time then the Regular Standard course time.

Moving Up in Obedience

6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Rally Obedience Classes:

Novice A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally nor Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX or instructed dog training classes is eligible for this class. The handler must own, co-own or be an immediate member of the dog owner's family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Once official notice of achieving this title is received by the CKC, a dog MUST move to either Novice B or Advanced A.

Novice B - for handlers or dogs who do meet requirements or Novice A. Dogs may compete in this class until they early a Rally Advanced leg.

Advanced B & Excellent B - Dogs/owners that competed in Novice B continue in B level classes. A dog may continue to compete in the Excellent B class indefinitely.

Exhibition Only - an official class for dogs NOT entered in a regular class, however dogs in non-regular classes or dogs that are not exhibiting at the trials MUST be entered in this class

Moving Up in Rally Obedience

6.7.1 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.
