Saturday: Novice, Open

Container, Interior & Exterior in all classes

Entries limited to 20 per component on a first come first serve basis, with a wait list after components have filled.

Entries open: May 05, 2025, 10 am Atlantic Daylight Time on a 1st received basis via email.

Entries close: May 14, 2025, 12 Noon Atlantic Daylight Time

Day-of entries will be available with limited spots up to the total of 20 entries per component. Move-ups will be permitted if available spots and made at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

WAIT LIST: We will maintain a Wait List. ALL entries must be received before the closing. Entries can be added from the wait list. Limited number of day of entries will be available, waitlist entries will take precedence.

ENTRY FEES:

Novice, Open: Single Component (Container, Interior, or Exterior) per dog per component \$10

Any combination of three (3) components (same dog) \$25

RULES:

A copy of the January 1, 2024, CKC Scent Detection Trial Rules & Regulations may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be issued for cancelling after the closing unless the spot can be filled from the waitlist. Refunds will only be issued after the match date.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- We will not be offering resets at this Trial. Only one dog per handler per class will be allowed.
- KOC respectfully reminds exhibitors that anyone discussing hides before the end of the Trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules.
- The Precincts of these Trials shall be the Sunshine Valley veterinary clinic, adjoining buildings, and the parking lots. Only dogs entered in the Trials may be on the precincts.
- The only dog permitted in the test area is the dog being tested.
- Be prepared to crate from your vehicle. There will be no crating inside the building. There will be a designated parking area.

- Due to space limitations, there will not be a designated spectator area at these events.
- All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the test and only if permitted by the judge. All persons must exercise care and control of any dog in their possession.
- Please give every dog and handler space.
- The KOC reserves the right to refuse an entry subject to CKC rules.
- Judging Schedules and Arm Band Numbers will not be available.
- Please advise if you are bringing a bitch in season. They must run last in their class and wear clean, properly fitted panties.
- No exhibition classes will be offered.
- Dogs may not be lame or have a known communicable disease.
- The Match Superintendent will be in full charge of the events that will be governed by CKC rules.
- The Kennebecasis Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, however KOC will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their dogs.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the Trial-giving Club to see that a Judge, Club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- No overnight recreational parking will be provided.
- No food will be available at the venue, several fast-food outlets are located nearby.
- If it is impossible to open or to complete the event because of riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather or other acts beyond the control of the Kennebecasis Obedience Club, no refund of entry fees or service fees will be made.
- The Kennebecasis Obedience Club will abide by any Covid regulations as required by Provincial Health Authorities at the time of the Trials, further information if needed, will be published in the Judging Schedule.
