EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show. **12 - 18 MONTH CLASS:** for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

EXHIBITION ONLY: for all dogs 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

MOVING DOGS TO "SPECIALS ONLY": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least 1 hour prior to the opening of the show. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

CHAPTER 4 – JUDGES

4.1.3. A judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to INDIGNITIES of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES & ENTRY FEES

8.8.2 Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

8.7.1 Withdrawal of Entries: When the premium list indicates that entries will be "limited", cancellation of entries will NOT be permitted. However, a dog may be substituted provided it is owned by the same person making the substitution.

CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

3.3.1 - Substitute Judge - when an advertised judge will not be able to fulfill his assignment, permission from the CKC to substitute the judge is required.... Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to one hour before the judging of the breed, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded

8.2.5—An error in the age specified class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour before to the start of the show.

8.5.8—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see sections 3.3.1, 3.5.1 ,8.5.4)

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and /or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled **start of the show** for which the dog is being moved up to.

12.2.2 - Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes including parades nor are they required to be listed in the catalogue. **This club reserves the right to limit the entry of 3-6 month old dogs to 2 per exhibitor.**

12.3.f—A puppy awarded Best Puppy In Breed is NOT required to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

To obtain an ERN, simply ...

- Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number.
- Please indicate coat type and size, if applicable.
- Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$57.60 + GST. Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian funds.
- Payment may be made with Visa or Master Card, personal or business cheque or money order. For Non-Members, please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada, please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Master Card number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within thirty (30) days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a thirty (30) day extension.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS

ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES:

Fees must accompany your entries. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a **\$50.00** fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

SHOW TIMES

Judging will start at 9:00 AM Friday. All start times will be specified in the judging schedule mailed or emailed to all exhibitors after entries close. Group judging will commence immediately following the breed judging. No two groups will be judged at the same time. Best In Show will follow shortly after the last group has been judged. Sunday judging will start at 8:00AM.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. EX PENS MUST BE LINED WITH PLASTIC SUPPLIED BY THE OWNER/HANDLER. PLASTIC CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE SHOW.
2. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building overnight, however, they will be left at the owner's/handler's own risk. There will be no over-night security. Over-night benching allowed in a specific, designated area ONLY. Check with Show Superintendent Kathy Horne.
3. DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. NON COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE SHOW. POOP/SCOOP RULES **STRONGLY** IN EFFECT!
4. There are NO dog bathing facilities at this venue.
5. We recommend booking your Hotel Reservations early.
6. **Electrical plug-in charge will be \$25.00 prepaid. At the show \$50.00**
7. Entry fees will not be refunded for cancellation of entries, if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.
8. If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
9. ****NOTE NEW TIME!! The show building will be opened Thursday, at 4:00 PM (NO SOONER) to 11:00 PM** for exhibitors to set up. The building will be open from 7:00AM to 11:00PM Fri & Sat; 6:30 AM to 7:00 PM on Sun.
10. Space is at a premium, therefore **EXERCISE PENS WILL BE LIMITED TO 1 EXERCISE PEN PER 5 DOGS ENTERED**. Pen size to be no larger than 4'x8".

At the discretion of the judge, designated ramp breeds (See Appendix H – List of Breed that may be judged on a ramp) may be examined on the ground or on a ramp. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner on the ramp or on the ground.

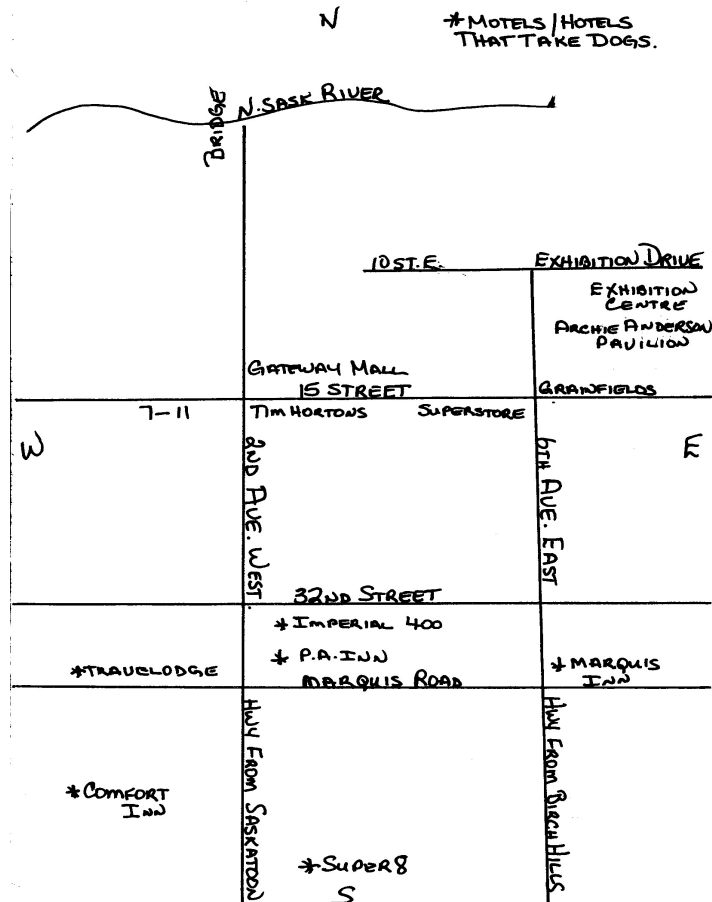
- 4.5.3 Breeds not designated as either table or ramp breeds are customarily examined on the ground. At the discretion of the judge, ramps may be used to judge any breed. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner.

NEW TRACKING FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC will be instituting a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at a CKC event, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a dog-specific tracking fee (\$55.00). This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.
