GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MCA

1. Entries must be received by the Event Secretary prior to closing date and time. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be done by telephone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time as stated in the premium list.
2. No entry form will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry forms are shown thereon. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the error was made. Exhibitors are expected to know the "Conformation Rules & Regulations". Rulebooks for Conformation Shows and Obedience Trial Rules are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cancellations after closing date and time are prohibited. All entries must be in the hands of the Event Secretary prior to the closing date and time.
4. MCA reserves the right to refuse any entry according to CKC rules.
5. The Event Superintendent will have full charge of the Show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
6. Private exercise pens in the building will be allowed only in RESERVE BENCHING areas. Plastic must be placed under all xpens. Abuse of this privilege will result in removal from the building. Please keep your area clean.
7. All dogs must be exercised in the exercise areas provided. Please clean up after your dog. Exhibitors must clean up outside the building grounds. Failure to do so may result in the offender and their entries being removed from the show.
8. No dog will be allowed in the show grounds area unless entered in the show.
9. No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete the shows because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of MCA.
10. MCA will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident or other mishap caused to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators whether the results of accident or otherwise. A dog should not be touched without the permission of the owner or handler.
11. The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. and closes at 9:00 P.M. each day. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk. There is NO night watchman. Dogs left in the building must have a contact cell phone number clearly attached to the crate.
12. Any dog excused by the Event Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class or for any awards for the balance of the show.
13. Puppies entered in classes other than puppy class are advised to check with their ring stewards prior to completion of breed judging to ensure that they are called back to compete for judging of puppy in breed.
14. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after entries close. Should these not be received within a reasonable period, please notify the Event Secretary.

15. A dog will be called three times for judging after which it will be marked absent.
16. Dogs should be at the show building one hour prior to judging. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when it is required for judging. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere.
17. All rules and regulations applicable to the All Breed show are in effect for the Specialties.
18. Manitoba Canine Association will not be providing an "In Transit" area. Dogs that are not entered in the show or trials will not be allowed in the arena or within 30 meters of the outdoor rings - offenders will be asked to leave the grounds.
19. All campers accept full responsibility for any damage that their vehicles may incur while camping at this site. By agreeing to camp on these grounds all rights or claims re damages that may incur are solely the camper's responsibility. All campers using the electrical are required to supply their own pigtail to connect to the electrical boxes. There will be no in and out priviledges for tow vehicles located east of the building on the grass. If you intend to use this vehicle throughout the weekend it must be parked in the arena parking lot.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated. Thank You.

Please Note: **MIXED BREEDS** will require a Canadian Companion Number to enter Performance Events. To apply for or to obtain information on the CANADIAN COMPANION OR PEN NUMBERS, contact the Shows and Trials Division at the Canadian Kennel Club or visit their web site at www.ckc.ca

Canadian Kennel Club Non-member participation fee as of January 1, 2011:

- a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.
- c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned solely by persons residing outside of Canada.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded. Winners shall be as follows.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also places in the GROUP as listed below.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13). Best Puppy in Breed – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is NOT required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch).

- (c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the judging of the breed by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees, however, WILL NOT be refunded.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the judging of the breed.

VETERAN CLASSES - This class is for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. This class will be divided into 7 years of age and under 9 years, 9 years of age and under 11, 11+ years of age. These dogs will compete for regular placements with the first place males and females in each age division competing for Best of Breed, Best Veteran in Specialty and Best Opposite Sex Veteran in Specialty. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration of Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Dogs not registered in Canada (CKC registered or with an ERN) must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for an event. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the event or all awards will be cancelled.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries are made. The test committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$45.00 service charge. Entry fee plus service charge for NSF cheques must be paid prior to the test.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

Canadian Kennel Club Non-Member Participation Fee

The non-member participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. For the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

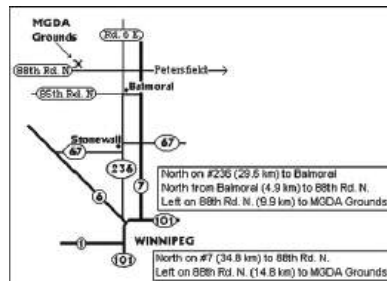

The Trial Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on trial grounds.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred".

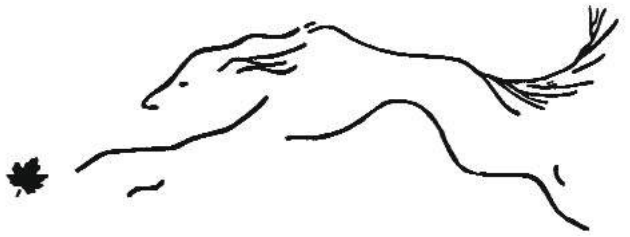

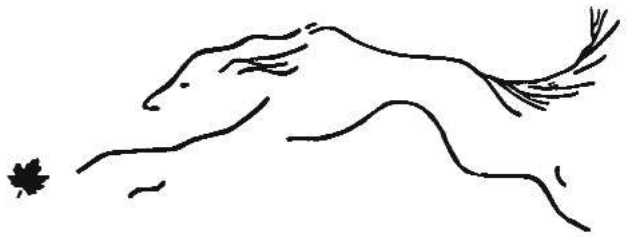
