The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

Rules

A copy of the rules pertaining to dog shows or obedience trials may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - * Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension. Please forward your request to:

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line.) The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received on or before the closing date and time. Official CKC Entry Forms MUST be used. Please PRINT OR TYPE YOUR ENTRIES. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex many be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- 3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show/trials Secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the CKC may compete in these

shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

- 7. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
- 8. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Tantramar Kennel Club, its officers, associates, Show Committee and Little Moe's Canine Academy, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. The Tantramar Kennel Club (& Little Moe's Canine Academy) will not be responsible for equipment left on site overnight.
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules
- The site will be open no earlier than 12:00 noon until 4:00pm & again after 5:30pm until dark on Friday May 20th for setup. The site will be open at 7:00 AM daily. Please be aware that this is also a place of business & that there will be other customers coming in on Saturday & Sunday mornings so it will be busy during that time. No Exhibitors will be allowed in for set-up between 4:00 5:30pm on Friday as that time is reserved for business customers.
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT ON SITE OVERNIGHT.
- BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring grounds.
- Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely was possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Due to the limited amount of space, the Superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the Superintendent in this regard.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- Please keep your dogs crated when unattended, and clean up after your dogs.
- SHOW PRECINCTS The precincts of the show shall be the fenced area of the rings and 3 feet surrounding the rings.
- **Parking** Yan Mowatt, & her staff, will be in complete charge of parking. Everyone is to abide by their instructions as they know the ground on the site & where best to park your vehicle.

Baby Puppy A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show 12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show

Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada

Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions

Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months and over, not in competition.

Veteran Class Dogs Must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be

spayed or neutered.

Altered class For sexually altered dogs only

NOTE: 4–6-month Exhibition only puppy~ if the puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration Number the Listing Fee is waived.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

| Dogs Competing: | 1 | 2 | 3-5 | 6-9 | 10-12 | 13 or more |

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.
