** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to start or to complete this event, no refund of entry will be made.

CKC has a Non-Member Participation Fee of \$64.00+ HST. This fee only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized-breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for "Temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date".

As of January 1, 2020, as per CKC regulations if a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The club will refund the entry minus the TCN fee and a 30% administration fee.

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$18.50, plus taxes.

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27 (aka Town Line Road). Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From CR 27 South: Follow CR 27 northbound through Thornton. Continue north. After 5 minutes, look for signs on your right that show you have to turn LEFT to stay on CR 27. When you see that sign, turn left continue on CR 27. When you come down the big hill look for our white flags on the west (left) side of the road. If you get to lights at Ardagh, you've gone too far.



Speed limit on the grounds is 10 km/h;

Anyone not in compliance with this will be asked to leave with no refund of entry fees.

Liability Agreement

I (we) acknowledge that Red Barn Event Centre and Simcoe performance Dogs has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this scent trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Please read the following rules:

To make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) No outdoor shoes allowed on the rubber flooring. Please bring a clean, dry pair of indoor shoes to trial in.
- 2) PLEASE drive slowly down the long lane way. Do not let your dogs out in the front of the property or anywhere near the house as this is a private residence! Also, the agility field is off limits to all dogs and people.
- 3) DOGS MAY NOT WALK IN THE BACK FIELD
- 4) Only Park in the WEST/MAIN parking lot area. Please respect the pylons
- 5) Dogs must be always on leash except when using the designated off leash area. No prong collars, choke chains or e-collars on the property. Dogs must be on a flat collar, martingale collar, or flat harness only.
- 6) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive. There is NO nose-to-nose contact in the Red Barn.
- 7) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 8) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 9) No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- 10) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 11) Be kind to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Alterations, substitutions, or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list.

Refunds

There are NO CREDITS nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date. Lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded with a 10% processing fee deducted, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. If dog is not present for assessment, a note signed by a veterinarian will be required for any refund or credit consideration.

Foreign Exhibitors

Personal US cheques will be accepted in US funds, but due to fluctuating currency rates they cannot be discounted. Please do not mark personal foreign cheques "Payable" in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Thank you.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are permitted to compete. They must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

Eligibility

Scent participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 6 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Performance Event Number (PEN) or eligible for the registration with the CKC or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

EVENT

Verification that your entries have been received will be emailed to you no later than six days before the event date. PLEASE contact us prior to the event date if you have not received an emailed confirmation from us.
