Notice To Exhibitors

All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the NADAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry.

- **All dogs MUST be registered with NADAC when entering a NADAC trial.** "Pending" registrations will not be accepted. You can register your dog on line at www.nadac.com. You will receive an e-mail confirmation with your dog's number immediately.
- The Trial Committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by the NADAC board of directors. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- In all agility classes the handler shall direct his/her dog through the course without a collar or lead. No food, toys, balls or other devices may be used within ten (10) feet of the entrance to the ring.
- All commands must be given in a sportsman-like manner, or they shall be faulted. The judge shall assess the faults to be equivalent to the degree of the offence, from five (5) fault penalty to elimination. Displays of *anger, foul language, or excessive harshness shall always be faulted.*

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30 service charge for returned checks. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- There will be no equipment familiarization.
- All exhibitors are responsible for the behaviour of their dog(s) and/or child(ren). Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or child(ren) engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund of fees will be made.
- All dogs must be kept on lead or in pens or crates when not competing in the ring.
- Unentered dogs will be allowed on the trial site, provided that they remain in the control of their owner/handler. Owners of unentered dogs which prove to be disruptive will be asked to leave the grounds.
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each Division except Chances as it is a pass/fail class only.
- A purple qualifying ribbon will be awarded for each qualifying round in each class.
- Injured dogs / bitches in season will be given a credit for the amount of 50% of entry fees provided the request, accompanied by a vet's letter, reaches the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial.

ALL DOGS MUST BE MEASURED except those jumping the maximum jump height, those having a permanent height card, those dogs in Skilled, Intro Level dogs and dogs jumping 16" in the Vet Dog or Jr.H Divisions.

Please go to www.nadac.com and consult the Exhibitor's Handbook to determine your dog's jump height !

Veteran Division (Veteran Dogs, Veteran Handlers, and Disabled Handlers)

- The Veteran division is open to:

Any dog age seven (7) years of age or older. The dog's age shall be determined by the dog's actual birthday, or the closest date, as known.

Any handler age 60 or older. The handler's age shall be determined by any piece of identification with their birth date listed.

Any handler who has a certificate of disability. Handlers with a disability shall present a copy of their disabled parking permit or a letter from their doctor.

If a handler wishes to enter any class as a VH/DH, they must enter all classes and all dogs that they compete with for that weekend as VH/DH. They may not enter particular classes or a particular dog using the VH/DH status while entering a different dog or different classes in the other divisions.

Dogs must enter the Veteran Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs in this division are given the allocated Veteran course times.

After their 12th birthday dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veteran Division.

IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC. Levels: Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

GENERAL AGREEMENT

I (We) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club or trial committee shall deem to be sufficient.
