### **INDIGNITIES**

20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this has occurred.

A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

## SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted.
- The club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the shows & trials, which will be governed by CKC RULES.
- The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show grounds.
- The Precincts of this trial will be the entire building in which The Training Hall is located and the surrounding grounds and parking lots..
- The owner of dogs entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the ring.
- Dogs must be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, not in the ring areas.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund entry will be made.
- IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE when necessary. There will be no paging of individual dogs.
- Dogs must be on leashes at all times on the show grounds or in the show building with the exception of the Obedience rings.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their children while at the show and will be held accountable for any damages caused by children playing unattended
- The entire show site is designated as NO SMOKING.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If bitches come into season after the closing date, a veterinarian's certificate, stating that the bitch was in season within the ten-day period before the trial must be in the Trial Secretary's hands before the start of that day's trial, in order to obtain a refund of entry fees.
- Limited Entry – Entries are limited to 7 hours of judging, based on 8 Novice entries per hour, 7 Open entries per hour and 6 Utility entries per hour. When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of their position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the trial for those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.
- Change of Entry: As per 6.9.1., the entry of a dog entered in an official obedience or rally trial class in accordance with these rules may be changed to another official class within the same trial. The change must be on the appropriate form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner or handler at least **thirty (30) minutes** before the start of the **trial**. Please note, that in order to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a PEN, an ERN, or a Miscellaneous Class Certification.
- All entries must be typed or distinctly printed and submitted on official and/or approved entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The OVGRC does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or for errors due to illegibility of information on an entry submitted by the owner or agent, or for entering a dog in a

class in which the dog is not eligible to enter or compete. **Entries must be signed by the owner or agent or the entry will be rejected.**

## ENTRIES

Note: Fees must accompany entries. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered Non- Payment of Entry and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by CKC. There will be a \$35.00 charge for NSF cheques refused or declined. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded. We will accept one entry form per dog for all shows, or for all trials.

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### ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds

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### CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

*The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.*

## THE SUSAN ROBERTS MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Susan Roberts Memorial Trophy (SRMT) has been established to recognize the combined field and obedience achievements by a Golden Retriever and their owner/handlers. The award will be given to the top performing Golden with a CKC and/or AKC field title at the end of the upcoming Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club (OVGRC) Obedience Trials described in this premium.

The trophy is in honour of Susan Roberts (1954-2020). For more than 30 years, Susan was active as a competitor, breeder, and club supporter. She was a long-time supporter of the Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club and served as board member and president.

Above all, Susan loved to learn new things and share her knowledge and passion for the breed. She was mentor to many in the Ottawa area and has helped grow a new generation of obedience and field competitors.

### **Criteria for Eligibility:**

Any Golden Retriever/Handler team with a CKC and/or AKC field title (i.e. a title from a working certificate series, or a hunt test or field trial series) entered in any official class in the OVGRC Obedience Trials on October 28 and 29, is eligible. To be considered handlers must also send the entry form, or the information requested in the Entry Form (below) to: [susanrobertsmemorialtrophy@gmail.com](mailto:susanrobertsmemorialtrophy@gmail.com)

### **Criteria for Winning:**

The SRMT will be awarded to the Golden Retriever/Handler team achieving the highest score in any official class during the OVGRC trial weekend. In the event of a tie, the trophy will go to the team with the most advanced field title. The trophy will be presented at the conclusion of the trials. Teams in the running for the trophy at the end of day Saturday October 28<sup>th</sup>, will be informed.
