Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing of entries, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten days of the trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial prior to the judging of the class and the club will refund entry fees.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues are available on a PRE-ORDER basis. Those who wish to pre-order at a price of \$3.00 may do so by indicating this on their entry form. There will be a limited number of catalogues available for sale at the trial for a price of \$5.00.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. Alterations, substitutions, or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY MARCH 23, 2011, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 4. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the trial.
- 5. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Credit Valley Kennel and Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the entire building of Campaign Dog Academy.

New – CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

In 2010 the Board of Directors passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting the Tracking Fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion:

Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee.
 Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Non-Member Participation fee: \$55.00 + HST Directions to Trial
