Entry Information

Eligibility:

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixed breeds. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a tracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A Tracking Number application is included in this premium.

Height Cards & Measurements:

Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (wither height less than or equal to 20") must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" Standard jump heights are exempt and also 16+" Vets/Juniors/ACE Standard are exempt.

Levels:

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled. If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles.

Note: Once you have Q'd at a higher level, you may NOT compete at a lower level.

Equipment:

Equipment will consist of non-slatted A-frame, Dogwalk and Teeter (all with rubber surface); Single jumps, (winged and wingless), Tunnels, Weave Poles (6 and/or 12 poles depending on Level) with 24" spacing, and Displaceable Tire Jump.

Prizes and Awards:

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Placements will be combined for 20+" and 24" dogs in all divisions.

HIT Rosettes Requirements:

Dogs must be entered in all runs both days to be eligible for HIT awards. HIT calculations are based on scores from Regular/Jumpers/Gamblers and both CH and ACE dogs will be eligible. HIT level determined as level the dog was entered in Regular class. HIT Aussie and HIT Other Breed will be based on the total Q points for that dog, regardless of level(s). Aussies must have an ASCA registration number to qualify for the Aussie HIT. Points for HIT are calculated as follows: Elite Q – 7 pts, Open Q – 6 pts, Novice Q – 5 pts. Each faulted Q run in Regular shall be given one-half the value of the equivalent level HITQ points. In the event of a tie, dog with the fastest combined YPS will be the winner.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available for viewing or download at: www.asca.org
- ASCA, TBASCO, and/or Tucker Creek Farm will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- o All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- Any ASCA members currently not in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed entry into the trial. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of fees will be paid.
- No refunds will be granted after the closing date. Refunds, less a \$25 administration fee, will be granted for bitches in season and injured dogs, if the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's letter and provided to the Trial Secretary no later than the start of the trial on Saturday.
- FEO (For Exhibition Only) We will accept FEO entries. Dogs entering FEO must be a minimum of 15 months of age. FEO entries may jump at a lower jump height but are not eligible for any prizes or awards. Any dog under 18 months must jump at a lower height. This is a non-qualifying division.
- Dogs showing threatening behaviour will be subject to either disqualification or excusal, per the ASCA Dog Aggression Rules. All TBASCO investigations and appropriate forms will be forwarded on to the ASCA business office. Dogs excused or disqualified under said policy will be excused from the remainder of the event and asked to leave, without refund of entry fees.

Tracking Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of "Service" is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a Tracking Number.

Frequently asked questions: Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

You do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock unless you want to earn ASCA titles. You need a tracking number to enter an Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or tracking test. Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA. Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog? If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments you will need to obtain a tracking number. What is the total cost for a tracking number? In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog you must be a member. The cost for a basic Service Membership is \$10 per owner if not already a current member. Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after

your membership has expired. This membership fee is in addition to the tracking number fee of \$10 per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you have only one dog the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs the cost would be \$30.

EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT - Send in with Entry Form

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of the entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here, "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America® affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to the persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state/province in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA[®], TBASCO (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Tanya Wheeler/Tucker Creek Farm harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.
