ENTRY FEES: TD - \$65.00 TDX - \$75.00
ACCEPTANCE DATE: 9 a.m. Wednesday August 22nd 2012
ENTRIES CLOSE: 5 p.m. Thursday September 20th 2012

A listing fee of \$9.41 (\$8.40 + H.S.T.) as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog if a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

All cheques or money orders are payable to **Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club** or **GVDOTC**

U.S. Exhibitors - To pay in Canadian funds, use Postal Money Orders or the equivalent made out in Canadian dollars. Personal cheques will be accepted only if payable in U.S. funds for the full amount of the entry. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At par" as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. THANK YOU.

As per CKC rules (6.1.19), we are accepting entries through CANADA POST ONLY with ONE entry per envelope. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS. Please make sure NO SIGNATURE IS REQUESTED on entries sent via Express Post.

All entrants will be notified by email or phone (if no email address is provided) when their entry has been received. Once the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be placed on the alternate list.

Refunds - Entry fees for dogs NOT entered in the Test will be refunded within 10 days of the tracking test. If a dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will only be given if their place is taken by an alternate.

Bitches in season will be allowed to compete and will run last. Pinch or prong collars are not allowed on the Test grounds.

Rendezvous - Scheduled for 8:00 a.m. Sunday, September 30th 2012 at Woodwynn Farms, 7789 West Saanich Road Victoria, B.C., where entrants will immediately draw lots for the order of the tracks. Confirmation of entry and directions to rendezvous point will be forwarded to each competitor upon receipt of entry.

A no host lunch at the farm will follow. Pre-registration is required as we will need to know attendance ahead of time. Further details will be available closer to the test date and will be sent to all those entered in the test. Contact Amalie Bush (Test Secretary) for registration.

Successful dogs - All exhibitors receiving a "pass" will be awarded a ribbon and a keepsake trophy.

Discipline Regulation: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. Non-member participation fee – Effective January 1, 2011

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
