Entries will close at 8:00pm sharp on Monday, September 17, 2012 (or when entry limit of 13 dogs per test has been reached) and the draw will be held immediately after the close at the home the field test secretary.

Entry fees: \$45.00 per dog per test (NOTE: morning and afternoon are separate tests)

Are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the **Atlantic Pointing Breed Club** and must accompany entry. The Entry Line may also be used (contact info below).

Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$9.65 (including HST) per dog per test entered and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries for this Field Test are accepted on condition that Vizsla Canada, its officials and members, and landowners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, or person in conjunction with, or during the running of this Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

TEST INFORMATION:

- **Courses & Birds -** Quail will be released. Other native game birds may be present. The tests course will be single course with bird field. Birds will also be released along the course.
- Gallery At the handler's discretion, a gallery of up to 6 spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. Spectators must wear blaze orange, remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judges, marshal & gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.
- Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** that can be run in approximately 4 hours of judging time.
- Starting times will be announced after the draw (earliest start will be 8:00 am). Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- FDJ & FD dogs will have 20-30 minutes to complete all aspects of the test. Dogs will be run individually.
- **Firearms** Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by **official gunners** only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired please **provide your own starting pistol** (calibre not less than .22 long).
- Blaze orange Blaze orange must be worn by any individual on the course during the FD tests.
- · Bitches in season will not be permitted to run. Refunds will be available for bitches that have come into season.
- **Collaring** a dog will be allowed only at the judge's instruction.
- Tracking Collars and any apparel that could be considered a training aid will not be permitted.
- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds before, during, or after the test without the permission of the Field Test Chairman or the Field Test Secretary.
- Accommodations: Camping will be allowed on the grounds on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights and will be restricted to marked areas. Facilities are limited so please come prepared. - **Prizes** Standard CKC qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test no ribbons will be mailed. A suitable prize will be offered to the highest qualifying FDJ Vizsla at each of the VC and GSPCC tests. In association with the Irish Setter Club of Canada field trial, a suitable prize will be offered to the top qualifying Irish Setter of the weekend (either the VC tests or GSPCC tests)
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test Rules are available from the CKC. NOTE: Make sure you review the rules for Field Dog Tests (available on the CKC website: <u>www.ckc.ca</u>)
- **Location** –Firefly Kennels, 636 Southside Road, Upper Stewiacke, Nova Scotia. The club wishes to thank Darren and Crystal Miller for use of the grounds. Please contact the trial secretary for directions to the grounds.
- Meals A barbecue lunch and refreshments will be available for purchase at a reasonable cost.
