Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex: except Specials Only) will be provided:

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JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.			
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.			
12 - 18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.			
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.			
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.			
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.			
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.			
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.			

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY	ogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show.		
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.		
EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 MONTHS)	Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades		

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or can be viewed online.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club Premium List, will also apply to this Specialty.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or 4. any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" - Conformation Show Rules and Regulations - Section 19.7.
- We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. 5. accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded here.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved</u> Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each

NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **no**t be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

Facility

Wet Noses is a 50-acre K9 Exclusive Facility. Free Wifi is available On Site. Dog Treats and Food will be available in the store. Dehydrated and RAW in stock. There will be a porta-potty available on site.

Camping

Limited Camping is available ON SITE. Reservations are required and can be booked online only at www.dogshow.ca, please see the RMWHCA Premium List. Cost is \$20 per night. No services - be prepared to be fully self-sufficient. Motor home generators must be vented upward, and as a courtesy to your fellow campers, generators will need to be turned off between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Ground is uneven; arrive prepared to level your unit. Please maintain appropriate social distancing (12 feet / 4 Metres) between camping units. Please do not camp near nor block the gates to the conformation specialty field nor the parking lot at Wet Noses.

Concession

Due to safety restrictions caused by COVID-19, there will **NOT** be a concession at these shows. Please bring your own food and drink.

Benching

Limited, free on-site benching is available within the show precincts. Please maintain appropriate social distancing (A MINIMUM OF 9 feet / 3 Metres) between benching areas.

Photographer

A show photographer will not be available at this show. A photo area will be setup for you to take pictures of your wins.

COVID-19 Requirements

All Covid Rules MUST be followed by all exhibitors, and they may be subject to change should the Provincial or Federal Covid-19 Restrictions change.

Waivers must be completed and returned with your mail-in entry. If you are entering online, your waiver must be completed and emailed to the show secretary - **TKO Show Services.**

MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED BY ALL EXHIBITORS AT ALL TIMES – _INCLUDING WHEN SHOWING YOUR DOG. THIS **MAY** CHANGE CLOSER TO THE SHOW.

Entry to the show zone / show rings will be granted only to those wearing a face mask. Individuals who are unable to wear a face mask due to a medical condition must wear a face shield. Exhibitors / participants must wear a face mask or shield that covers their nose and mouth at all times in the show zones / show rings/ or within 9 feet of ANY other exhibitor or show volunteer.

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German Shepherd Club of Canada / Wet Noses Inc. COVID-19 Requirements

General Required Practices

- 1. GSDCC members, judges and exhibitors are required to follow Federal, Provincial, Local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each show will also be followed.
- 2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 9 feet / 3 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family or cohort unit.
- 3. Masks are required on the show grounds and when showing your dog. Masks are provided by the exhibitors for their personal use. Masks are required in all common areas where social distancing is not guaranteed.
- 4. Show and Go Rules are in effect _once your breed judging is complete you are required to leave the show grounds and return to your vehicle or your camping spot. Do not enter the show grounds more than 1 hour before your estimated breed start time. No crates or ringside tables are allowed around the rings.
- 5. There will be plenty of hand sanitizer around the facility for personal use and sanitizer will be provided in the porta-potty
- 6. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Disinfect gate latches, if touched.
- 7. No handshakes or hugging.
- 8. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
- 9. Bring your own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens or markers will be available.
- 10. As you park at Wet Noses, leave sufficient space between vehicles to allow for effective social distancing.

Information applicable to all participants

- 1. The show grounds will likely have a limit regarding the number of people that are allowed on the show grounds at a given time. This limit will be set closer to the show date and detailed information will be included in the judging schedule. In addition, mask requirements and other COVID rules may change closer to the show date and detailed information on all these rules will be included in the judging schedule.
- 2. Take your win ribbon only if you plan on keeping it. Do not give ribbons back to the GSDCC.
- 3. The show secretary's designated space will be considered sacred ground. Barriers will be set up using a 9 Feet / 3 Metre perimeter to protect the show secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the show secretary will be asked to leave the show grounds and may not return for the duration of the show. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.

Show Practices

- 1. Each exhibitor will complete a waiver of liability for GSDCC and Wet Noses Inc as part of their entry (either online entry or mailed entry). No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required waiver. If you enter online, please print and bring a copy of your signed waiver if you have guests accompanying you. If you enter via a mailed entry, please ensure your paper entry includes a copy of your signed wavier.
- 2. Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the show grounds and will not be allowed to return.
- 3. It is required all exhibitors wear a mask on the show grounds.
- 4. MAINTAIN 9 Feet / 3 Metre SPACING at all times.
- 5. Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day.
- 6. Wristbands will be issued to all exhibitors and guests provided the guests names are included on the signed waiver that must accompany your entry form.
