#### **Event Rules:**

- Training held rain or shine

- Six foot lead required
- No flexi-leads allowed
- Registration will be confirmed by email
- Waiver must be signed
- Participants must wear a mask at all times

#### Training Classes:

**1. Introduction to Quarry (IQ) FOR BEGINNERS:** On leash, your dog will meet the rat in a secure cage above ground, and follow the rat through an above ground tunnel. Successful dogs will then be off lead, in a fully fenced area, to explore the 10 foot underground tunnel to the quarry.

**2. Junior Earthdog (JE):** This class is for a more experienced earthdog, ready for a 30 foot tunnel, and problem solving.

**3. Senior Earthdog (SE):** This class is for dogs about to enter SE, and problem solving for the Senior dogs.

**4. Master Earthdog (ME):** This class will be for the dogs about to enter ME, and problem solving in the various segments of ME.



### **Training Seminar Registration Form**

□ Introduction to Quarry (IQ) training: For absolute beginner dogs that have never been introduced to a rat, nor been in a tunnel, or dogs that have unsuccessfully tried IQ before.

□ Junior Earthdog (JE) training: For dogs ready for the longer 30 foot tunnel which has multiple turns.

- Senior Earthdog (SE) training: For dogs with their JE title.
- □ Master Earthdog (MÉ) training: For dogs with their SE title.

### **Directions to Willowbrae:**

## **Directions:**

- **From Toronto or From the East**: Exit the HWY 401 westbound to the HWY 410 and go north. Take the extension that connects to HWY 10 north. Continue until you reach King St. Turn left. Stay on King St. into Terra Cotta. At the stop sign in Terra Cotta go straight through, staying on King St. After the bend in the road to the left you are now on Winston Churchill Blvd. You will cross the bridge over the Credit River and continue up the hill. Just past the top of hill you will see #12900 on your right. If you reach the 80 km speed limit sign you have passed the driveway.
- **From West**: Take HWY 401 east to Trafalgar Rd (exit #328 from 401) and go north about 6.5 km to the 10th Side Rd. Turn right and continue to Norval. Turn left onto Winston Churchill (also called Adamson St at this point) and keep going until you reach #12900, which is on your left.
- **From Niagara**: If you take the QEW east to Bronte Rd (HWY # 25 Milton), and travel north to Britannia Rd., turn right at the light. Continue to Trafalgar Rd and turn left (north). Once you pass over the HWY 401 follow the directions 'Coming from West'. OR take HWY 407 east to HWY 401 East exit and then exit the 401 at Winston Churchill Blvd. and travel north to #12900.

**NOTES**: House numbers on the left and right sides of Winston Churchill do not follow numeric order, so look at the numbers on the west side!
