### **DIRECTIONS:**

### FROM SUSSEX AREA

Take Exit 446 (toward Moncton Centre/Riverview) Merge onto Berry Mills Rd/NB 128E. At lights by Moncton Coliseum turn Right onto Millennium Blvd when you see Permatile & Supplies Ltd bear left to stay on Millennium Blvd continue through the 1<sup>st</sup> set of lights and you are now on John Street the Adeline Animal Hospital is at the Corner of High and John 2<sup>nd</sup> set of Lights

### FROM NOVA SCOTIA

### Take Exit 459A off the Trans Canada

At the end of the exit ramp turn right onto Elmwood Drive. Go straight through 4 sets of lights. At the 5<sup>th</sup> set take right merge lane onto Morton Ave. and continue straight through 4 sets of lights, you are now on Connaught Ave. take the 1<sup>st</sup> left onto High Street and go straight. The Adeline Animal Hospital is on your left just after the 2<sup>nd</sup> set of lights. (Corner of High & John)
