

Directions to Trial Site

From North of Cobble Hill:

Follow Highway 1 South to the Cobble Hill Rd exit. That is at the traffic lights opposite the Country Grocer at Valley View Centre. Turn right and follow Cobble Hill Rd to Thain Rd (first road to your right there is a little greenish brick building). Turn right and you will cross the train tracks. Continue to Kingburne Dr. (second road to your right) Turn right and continue just before you crest the second hill to 3625 on the left.

From South of Cobble Hill:

Follow Highway 1 North to Hutchinson Rd exit. (There is a sign on the Highway just before that says Cobble Hill to your left). Turn left and follow it to the stop sign. Turn right onto Cobble Hill Rd and follow that to Thain Rd (there is a little greenish brick building). Turn left and you will cross the train tracks. Continue to Kingburne Dr. (second Road to your right) Turn right and continue just before you crest the second hill to 3625 on the left.

There will be pooper scoopers and buckets strategically placed on the trial grounds. If you prefer to use plastic bags PLEASE DO NOT PUT THEM IN THE POOP BUCKETS! Put them in the garbage. The buckets get dumped into the manure pile at the farm. Thanks for your cooperation.

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC."

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states:

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB
Non-Member Participation Fee
(Effective January 1, 2011)

Policy:

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned

by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

There are 2 options for non-members:

a) Join the CKC

b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles, or awards earned and is assessed against the owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.

Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.

Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.

The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.
