West Kootenay Kennel Club welcomes mixed, and unrecognized breeds with CKC ID Numbers

DIVISIONS: There are 3 divisions – Regular, Selected, and Veteran. A dog may enter classes in any division *but in Selected may not move back and forth between divisions during a trial. Veterans cannot move back to Regular.*

Regular Division is for all dogs of any breed and any level and any jump height.

Selected Division is for dogs that need more time or should not jump the regular jump heights. *They run the same course as Regular dogs but jump one height lower and receive 10% more time than Regular division dogs. Dogs moving into the Selected or Veteran divisions can move laterally and take any legs they have earned in the Regular division with them. Once a dog has moved to the Veteran division it may not move back to the Regular division. Dogs may move from the Selected division to the Regular division. However, they cannot take legs earned in the Selected division to the Regular division but must either start at the level they were already at in the Regular division or start at Novice if they had not previously run in the Regular division. The dog must be entered only in Selected division and may not move back and forth between the Selected division and the Regular division during a set of trials.*

Veteran Division is for dogs 7 years or older. Veteran dogs may jump 2 jump heights lower than regular jump height and receive 10% more time than regular division dogs. Dogs cannot revert back to Regular or Selected divisions. Veteran course times are based on dogs original jump height

Selected and Veteran Course Times:

10% will be added to the standard times

LEVELS: . See your rule book for definitions of requirements in each level.

- There are 4 levels in Standard, JWW, and PAD. Novice, Intermediate, Excellent, and Master Excellent.
- No levels in Steeplechase or Jumps with Tunnels, all dogs run the same course
- A and B levels have been eliminated in all classes

Novice: A dog must be started at the Novice Level for each Class: Standard, Jumpers with Weaves, and PAD.

Intermediate: Is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Title.

Excellent : is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title

Master Excellent: is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title

NOTE: The new Rule book is dated January 2023 and is available on the CKC website at www.ckc.ca

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing.

New Rules:

1. Senior Handlers and Handlers with Disability:

Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time or a modified points requirement for PAD. Proof of age or disability will not be requested. A handler **MUST** indicate on the entry form by entering as senior/disabled handler to receive modified times/reduced number of points. The handler's dog shall be entered at its current competition jump height and category. Time and points concession is for the handler. See agility rule book pages 13 and 14, section 2.12

2. For Fun Only (FFO):

Dogs can run in the For Fun Only (FFO) class in any category. The owner would be allowed to take their dog into the ring with a toy. Toys are allowed but must be identified to the judge prior to entering the ring. No Food allowed. A maximum course time of 60 seconds would be allotted. FFO entries must meet eligibility rules as dogs running for Qualification. FFO entry fee is \$25.00/run. The handler **MUST** indicate on the entry form by entering For Fun Only (FFO). FFO runs are not eligible for awards or prizes. See agility rule book pages 36 and 37, section 8.1 Divisions (8.1.4 – 8.1.7)

Height Divisions—owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

All courses have clearly designated start and finish lines with all obstacles/jumps clearly and sequentially numbered. The course layout for each class will be posted in an easily accessible area at least ½ hour before the start of the class.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Please check your confirmations for accuracy.

Equipment and Course Familiarization:

- A warm – up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials
- Contact Familiarization will be available from 8:30 – 8:50 am each day, Novice dogs given priority.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. Only those entered in a class are permitted to walk the course.

Same Day Entries: Same day entries will not be allowed

List of Awards and Prizes:

- Ribbons will be provided for 1st – 4th in each class and jump height
- Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each agility trial
- Rosettes will be awarded for CKC Titles earned and handed out by the Show Secretary.

General Information:

1. Trial Precincts:

The precincts of the trial are all areas reserved for the sole use of the West Kootenay Kennel Club. The parking area and grass areas is reserved for our trial. Only Dogs entered in official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial

2. Agility Rules and Regulations:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

3. Withdrawal of Entries:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry and receive a full refund at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the trial secretary no later than the official closing date and time as stated in the premium list. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the trial

4. Foreign Exhibitors: Current Covid 19 at time of trial will be followed.

5. Bitches In Season:

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch comes into season after their entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, when a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.

6. Cancellation Of Event:

Should the West Kootenay Kennel Club need to cancel the event due to Provincial or Federal regulations, all entry fees will be returned, less any expense incurred by the club

7. No Concession on Site: Or restaurants near-by. Bring your own food, treats and water for you and your dog(s)

8. Same day move ups will be allowed:

A dog that has received 3 qualifying scores from at least 2 different judges may be moved up to the next level provided that the course level is higher and the request is received prior to the commencement of the trial. EG. Novice Standard 1 to Intermediate Standard 2. See Trial Secretary for official form.

9. Eligibility:

- Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 18 months of age to participate
- May be spayed, neutered, or debarked
- May not be lame, have tape or bandages
- Have a CKC registration number
- Have an Event registration Number (ERN)
- Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
- Have a Canine Companion Number (CCN)
- Have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- Have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

Dogs that are eligible for a CKC or ERN number but don't yet have one should have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). These can be obtained free of charge online from the CKC. For more information about the TCN: <https://www.ckc.ca/en/News/2019/December/Temporary-Competition-Numbers-Self-serve-Online-R>.

All recognized breeds that are considered Listed dogs must obtain a TCN before the closing date of entries

- All dogs are to be certified to be free of all communicable diseases
- Dogs entered must have current immunization status

10. Maps: Each morning, the days maps will be posted on site.

11. Running Order will be sent by email to exhibitors after the closing date.

12. West Kootenay Kennel Club does NOT use Electronic Timers

13. This Trial will not include the wall or broad jump in any courses

14. There shall be no smoking on the grounds at any time

15. The trial will run rain or shine, come prepared for all weather conditions

16. All dogs must be under control, on a leash or crated except when it is their turn to run

17. One inside washroom will be available

18. The site is the private residence of Dan and Glenda Harris, please be respectful and clean up after yourself and your dog
