This is a team event; each team must consist of 1 dog and 2 handlers.

*Note: The 'catcher' should be someone the dog prefers or will be excited to run to where the 'releaser' can be anyone with the skill & strength required to restrain the dog until released to start their run. If you are entering more than one dog, it is highly recommended you bring more hands. Volunteers will be limited; however, if you are unable to bring help to release your dog(s), please let us know upon your arrival so we can arrange for assistance.

These events are limited to 75 entries each.

Day of entries will be accepted if trials are not full. A stand-by list will be kept in accordance with CKC rules.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The Event Chairman will be in full charge of the events which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Sprinter rule books are available from the CKC (updated January 2024)
- Entries made through Dogshow.ca will be acknowledged by email, with receipt.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability,
 please make your needs known to the club in advance. Please contact the event secretary to ensure that
 we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

RUNNING THE EVENT:

- Inspections will begin at 8:30AM, there will be a short break between event's 1 & 2 each day.
- Lure operator: Morgan Conrick
- Dogs will run once per event, there will be two events per day.
- Come prepared for rain or shine and water for yourself and your dog.
- Do not leave dogs unattended. Tie outs are not permitted.
 - o Lameness inspections will be done before each run near the trial secretary tent.
- Lame or unfit dogs (by the opinion of the inspection committee) will be excused, and their entries refunded.
- Females in season will be permitted to run but must where snug-fitting panties and will be placed at the end of the run order. Please notify the secretary in advance so arrangements can be made.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, however handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they will be refunded their entry and excused.
- The club reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Muzzles, fitted, flat buckle collars (no tags) and catch collars are permitted. The dog may also run 'naked'.
- Flexi leads, prong collars and shock collars are not permitted.
- No dogs on the field at any time once the runs begin. Any dog on the field when it is not your turn running
 will be charged a \$10 fine on first offense. Any dog on the field after the first offense may be excused for
 the weekend.
- This is a physically intensive sport. Ensure you properly warm up your dog before their run and cool down your dog after.
- No exhibitors are permitted to walk the track during active competition. If the releaser enters the track more than 3 meters from the start line the team will be eliminated.
- The dog finishing their event must be caught, leashed, and exit the field before the subsequent dog may be permitted to enter the field.
- Clean up after your dog(s) and yourself (including cigarette butts).

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted: however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank you.

No entry will be accepted without payment in full. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy funds. Thank you!

The owner of a dog entered in this event is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event.

	of CKC. The fee is \$64.00 + 5% GST.

	awards and titles to be cancelled.			
c)	"These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not

If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved. This fee does not have to be paid before entering these events.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an</u> **ERN - Event Registration Number**.

This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a

foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA, or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name, and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$64.00 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

About the Event

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS:

participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
 - have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.
 - have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

EARNING POINTS:

The dog's time to complete the 100-meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater handicap is 1.25.(b) 12" up to less than 18" handicap is 1.5.
 - (c) Below 12" handicap is 2.0.

Points - 360 divided by the dog's time produces the dog's KPH which is multiplied by the dog's handicap to result in the number of points earned. Example: a 14" tall dog takes 18 seconds to complete the course. 360/18 seconds = 20 KPH x 1.5 = 30 points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

Please be sure to enter the correct height category. If you are unsure of your dog's height, please measure them.

AWARDS AND TITLES:

A flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog that completes a qualifying run.

A rosette will be offered for new titles, be sure to add your dog's name to the new title board!

Ribbons can be retrieved from the event secretary between runs.

NOTICE: You MUST select the VETERAN class on your entry for points to count towards veteran titles. If the selection is not made: your dog's points will go toward regular titles, regardless of their age.
