ENTRY FEES

Entry Fees WC - \$40

WCI - \$45 WCX - \$50

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) fee of \$10.50 is applicable per dog per event unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number on the dog being entered or Event Registration Number (ERN) number.

Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the Event Registration Number (ERN) fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Ducks, pheasants or pigeons may be used


Running order will be randomly selected. Multiple entries by the same owner/handler will be separated.

Discipline
