Desiree started her dog training career in 2002 when she decided to bring home 2 Siberian Husky sibling puppies T'ai and Chi. Training the puppies was an intriguing and rewarding adventure and she realized quickly that her passion for working with dogs was just as fulfilling as her passion for training people.

In 2003, Desiree decided to make a career change. She went from being a Director of Training in the Health & Fitness Industry to launching her own pet care business called Fido'N Friends in Motion. As her puppies and business grew, Desiree delved deeper into dog training and completed an extensive 2.5 year internship with Terry Long, she attended 2 Bob Bailey Chicken Camp workshops and received her Counseling Certificate from the San Francisco SPCA Academy for Dog Trainers with Jean Donaldson. In addition, Desiree is one of the first instructors to complete the apprenticeship and certification program in K9 Nose Work. She is a Founding Certified K9 Nose Work Instructor (CNWI) under the National Association of Canine Nose Work. Her initial 4 years of training was with the 3 founders of the sport. Desiree has had the enjoyment of working with most breeds, from Terriers to Malamutes. She currently has 5 dogs of her own, 2 Siberian Huskies, T'ai and Chi and 3 Border Collies, Stinger, Daim and Pace. All 5 dogs compete in Agility, Obedience, Rally and Canine Nose Work. Her dogs have earned a number titles and awards in the various venues. Desiree's youngest BC, Pace, became the 2011 USDAA Cynosport World Games - Dog Agility Steeplechase National Champion. Stinger, her oldest Border Collie, became the 2011 USDAA Cynosport World Games - National Relay and National DAM Team Champion. Both dogs have also competed at the AKC World Team Tryouts with great success. Stinger competed in the 2009 and 2010 AKC Agility Invitational. T'ai is one of the top Siberian Huskies in the country for both AKC and USDAA. He has earned numerous MACH's and has also earned an invitation to attend the AKC Agility Invitational six years in a row. In 2009 he made it into the finals and took 3rd place in the 24 inch division. In 2012 T'ai made it in to the finals at the AKC National Agility Championship and took 3rd. place in the 24 inch class: one week before his 10th. birthday.
