Entries will be accepted by mail only. Payment must be included with entry, but no cheques will be cashed until trial closing date. Confirmation of entries will be acknowledged by email within five business days of entry receipt.

Notes to US exhibitors. Fees are due in Canadian funds. American cheques must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Do not mark cheques “Payable in Canadian Funds” or “At Par,” as they will not be cleared by the banks. Bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds simplify the process.

Border Crossing Government regulations require that any dog brought into Canada must have a current Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry.

Females in season

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian’s certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

Judges' Biographies

Margaret Chandler has been actively involved with dog training for the past thirty-one years. She has achieved advanced titles on her own dogs (German Shepherds and Newfoundlands) in Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Draft and Water Rescue in both Canada and the USA. She is currently training and titling her two Belgian Tervurens in Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Agility and Herding.

Margaret has taught Obedience and Rally All Breed Classes for many years for the Great Dane Club of British Columbia, gaining valuable knowledge about how the different breeds work. She likes helping dogs work towards achieving their potential in activities for which they were bred.

For the past fifteen years, she has judged Obedience and later Rally for both CKC and AKC; Obedience for ASCA; Draft Tests for CKC; and Water Tests for the Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada.

Margaret wishes all exhibitors good luck and hopes they have a most enjoyable weekend with their dog.

Bruce Fraser is another popular local judge, and a lawyer by profession. He is active in the obedience ring with his own Miniature Schnauzers, when he is not judging elsewhere in Canada and the United States. Bruce is also interested in conformation, and is licensed to Judge Groups 4 and 5, and has a new permit for Group 3.

Sharon Smith comes to us from Ontario, where she has been involved in all breed training for 26 years. She became a tracking judge in 1994 and an obedience judge in 1999, and has judged across Canada, the United States and Bermuda.

Sharon and her husband have been breeding German Shepherd Dogs under the Tersha prefix for 20 years. She has owned and trained an Obedience Victrix and an Obedience Victor, and has placed in the Top 5 Obedience German Shepherd Dogs several times. She has also placed in the Top Obedience Dogs in the Herding Group as well as in the Top 10 Obedience Dogs in Canada.

There is an 18 acre off leash dog park just behind the George Preston Centre at 206th St and 44A Ave. Several blocks away is a very large passive park at 207th St. and 36th Ave, which is also an excellent place for dog walking (just watch out for the flying Frisbees, as it is a disc golf venue.)

Limited crating is available in the building.
There is no concession onsite.

Rules and regulations governing these trials

1. Dogs must be kept under control and on leash at all times within the building with the exception of the obedience ring. Dogs not entered in these trials will not be allowed inside the George Preston Centre with the exception of Certified Assistance Dogs.
2. Collars other than those specified in Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations are not allowed within the ring.
3. Dumbbell Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of, accident or injury to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
4. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called. (Sec. 8.6.2) Any judging conflicts must be reported to the steward as early as possible. All efforts will be made to accommodate exhibitors, but judging will not be delayed to do so.
5. If, because of civil disturbance, Act of God, or other events beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.
6. All children must be under the control of an accompanying adult.
7. The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
8. The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and its grounds. The Trial Chairman shall have full control of these shows and trials, which are governed by Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) rules.
9. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs, both inside and outside the trial building. Dogs are not permitted in the washrooms nor in the skating rink.
10. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in Novice A.
11. A person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in Open A.
12. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCh title may not handle dogs in Utility A.
13. The club reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.
14. The precincts of this trial are the George Preston Centre Curling Rink itself.
15. As per CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, no judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial shall be subject to indignities of any kind.
