JUDGE'S BIOS

TERRY GAINES

As a teenager I wanted a horse, my parents would only go for a dog. The dog I got was a Labrador Retriever and this started my love for the breed. I became involved with the sport of dog obedience and conformation followed shortly after. I have trained in obedience for 55 years and produced 8 OTCH dogs. My wife and I have been breeding Labradors for 35 years under the prefix Gainspride, producing specialty and best in show winners. I have also trained and shown Miniature Pinschers. I have been judging obedience for 25 years, rally since its addition to CKC and have 3 conformation groups, Sporting, Toys and Herding.

ROGER and PAULA HARTINGER

Roger and Paula Hartinger have been involved in pure bred dogs for over 50 years. Their first breed was Great Danes, but they are best known as exhibitors and breeders of Standard Schnauzers. They also bred Basset Hounds and Lakeland Terriers, and owned and exhibited West Highland White terriers and Beagles. As AKC licensed handlers they exhibited a variety of other breeds.

In 1975 they were granted judges approval by the AKC. Since that time they have judged extensively throughout the Americas and in over 30 other countries. Shows they have judged include Westminster Kennel Club, AKC/Eukanuba shows and two World Shows. Both are approved for all breeds.

Roger has served as president of two all breed clubs, a parent breed club, and two specialty clubs, and was a delegate to the AKC for 15 years. He now serves on an AKC Trial Board. Paula has been secretary of an all breed club and the DJAA, president of two specialty clubs, and show secretary of two all breed clubs.

SHIRLEY HUBENIG

Shirley has been involved in showing, breeding, training, trialing and teaching obedience for over 40 years. She began with Siberian Huskies and owned and trialed the first Utility titled Siberian Husky in Canada and bred and trained Sibes for 13 years. For the past 30 some years Dobermans have been her love, taking 4 to their Dual Championships. Her first Doberman was a multi BIS and BISS boy who was top obedience Doberman in Canada his first year out. During these years Shirley was also a handler showing over 20 different breeds to their championships.

Shirley now resides with a 3 yr. old Dobie boy who finished his championship as a Junior Puppy and went High in Trial last year at the Canadian Doberman National Specialty trial and now working on his Rally Excellent. Shirley is also the proud owner of a Standard Poodle who completed her Championship as a Junior Puppy and her CD with 3 High in Classes and a High in Trial and achieved her Rally Novice, Advanced and Excellent all in one year.

Shirley is a CKC licensed obedience and rally judge and is also licensed for the top half of Group 3, excluding Boxers, and is on permit for the remainder which she expects to complete this year. She will then be on permit for the Herding Group.

WALTER PINSKER

Mr. Walter Pinsker started to breed and show Boxers with his wife Monika in 1969. Together they produced well over 100 champions, who in turn have been awarded Best in Show honours over 150 times. They produced the number one boxer in Canada and number one all breed dog in Japan. Mr. Pinsker and his wife have also owned/bred/exhibited Smooth Fox Terriers, Shiba Inus, Whippets and Akitas. Mr. Pinsker started to judge dogs in 1978 and has been licensed to judge all breeds since 1990. Mr. Pinsker has adjudicated all over the world including the USA, Canada, Mexico, South Africa, Argentina, Brazil, Peru, Columbia, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Philippines, Japan, Venezuela, Chile, Costa Rica, Germany, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand, India, Tasmania, Malaysia, Czech Republic, China, Ecuador and Norway.

Walter has had the honour to judge specialties in the following breeds: Boxers, Akitas, Whippets, Gordon Setters, American Cocker Spaniels, Borzois, All Dachshunds, Norwegian Elkhounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Bernese Mountain Dogs, Doberman Pinschers, Great Danes, Great Pyrenees, Newfoundland, Rottweilers, Samoyeds, St Bernards, Airedale Terriers, Welsh Terriers, specialties on the entire Toy Group, specialties of the entire Non Sporting Group, Bouviers des Flandres, German Shepherd Dogs, Bullmastiffs, Shib Inus, Siberian Huskies, Minature and Giant Schnauzers, Bulldogs and Yorkshire Terriers.

NANCY POPOVICH

I have been involved in purebred dogs for forty-five years, successfully exhibiting Airedale, Wire Fox and Lakeland Terriers under the Samaralyn Reg'd banner. Owner-handled and conditioned, all my champions were multiple group winners and nationally ranked top five in breed in very limited shows. Several were also BIS and BISS winners. Number one Airedale in Canada was achieved in 1976, and in 1993 number one Lakeland in Canada.

Retired from exhibiting in 1994, I am now a Canadian Kennel Club licensed all breed judge. A charter member of the Canadian Dog Judges Association, I held the position of Editor of the CDJA national newsletter for seven years.

I have been honored to judge specialties and national specialties in various breeds. Internationally, I have judged in Australia, Brazil, New Zealand, South Africa, Taiwan, and United States. No longer actively breeding and exhibiting, I enjoy ring stewarding, writing fiction, drawing, computers, and reading.

DOGS **MUST** BE ENTERED IN THE SHOW OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY TO BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. THE PRECINCTS OF THIS SHOW SHALL BE A 25 FOOT PERIMETER AROUND THE RINGS.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **MOUNTAIN DAYLIGHT TIME.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTH CLASS - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE

NOVICE A - The Novice A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under section No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE B - The Novice B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B Class at any one trial.

NOVICE C - The Novice C Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title C.D., C.D.X., U.D. or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the losing date of the trial in which it is to be entered.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - The Novice Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Classes. Novice Intermediate Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises.

OPEN A - The Open A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. . The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned its C.D.X. title is not eligible for entry in this class but may be entered in the Open B Class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

OPEN B - The Open B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. must enter in the Open B Class. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exerciseunless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Open A and Open B classes at any one trial. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Open Class B at the same trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times.

UTILITY A - The Utility A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

UTILITY B - The Utility B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at the ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

CLASSIFICATION - RALLY OBEDIENCE

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R. N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the Dog has won the title. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

RALLY NOVICE B.- Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

BORDER CROSSING

A valid and current rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the United States. Increased security at the border crossing also requires a valid Passport for all persons.
