## **COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FOR 2020 SHOW**

At the time of this notice (Sept. 15, 2020) THE Government of Saskatchewan has set guidelines for social gatherings. Based on those guidelines the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club (PAKOC) will be offering indoor benching and grooming with the following protocols:

#### MASKING

- All participants are required to bring your own masks.
- Masks must be worn any time that you move out of your own personal benching area.
- All common areas (including the rings, Show Secretary's table, rest rooms, etc.) where social distancing cannot be guaranteed, require masks to be worn there will be no exceptions.
- No spectators, crates or ringside tables will be allowed around the rings.
- You are not required to wear a mask in your own personal benching area, but it is recommended. Any one <u>visiting</u> your benching area must be masked.

#### **UPON ARRIVAL**

- The names of the people in your party are required on ALL entry forms. In order to keep our numbers down, we request that you bring as few people as possible in your party. Only persons listed on our entries will be allowed into the building. Wrist bands will be issued to all named persons—please wear them all weekend.
- We ask that exhibitors allow a few extra minutes when they arrive at the building each day to allow for temperature scans and health assessments before entering the building. DO NOT ARRIVE on the premises and expect to rush into the ring.
- You will be required to check in upon arrival and <u>provide a signed</u> <u>copy of the required waiver</u> BEFORE continuing on into the venue.

#### **BENCHING/POWER**

- We will be offering benching with power. Please note that all exhibitors using blow dryers are required to bring their own popup/shelters with sides attached. Benching spaces with power are 10' x 10' and there is limited availability.
- All other reserved grooming will be 8' x 8' with 6' social distancing space between benching areas. Due to the 6' distance between benching sites, there is a very limited amount of unreserved benching (6' x 8' spaces)

#### **ARMBANDS / CATALOGUES**

- Armbands and Catalogues will be at the Show Secretary's table in envelopes ready for pick-up, by exhibitor's/handlers' last name. In order to avoid cross-contamination all exhibitors/handlers handling multiple entries will be given duplicate armbands.
- Please know your armband numbers you will have received these numbers via email from DogShow.ca There is no "public" catalogue available for your use at the Show Secretary's table.

#### **MOVE-UPS**

- The Show Secretary's table is in a common area, therefore a mask will be required when processing a Move-Up.
- Please have ALL of the information required in order to move a dog up with you as there will be no "public" catalogue available for your use.

#### **MARKERS / SIGNS**

• There will be markers at ringside and in the ring. Directional signage is to be followed

#### RIBBONS

• Ribbons will be handled by the Ring Steward only. If you take the ribbon presented, please DO NOT return it to the table. We ask that you keep it or not take it at all.

#### PRE-ORDERED FOOD

• Food can be ordered through the premium list (menu will be included). Please prepay with your entry. Lunches will be delivered, individually packed with cutlery and condiments.

#### SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES

- Hand sanitizer and hand wipes will be on tables throughout the building.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for proper social distancing when setting up their tents/areas.
- The PAKOC will do everything we can to help keep everyone safe, HOWEVER it is up to you as the exhibitor to follow the rules of social distancing and mask wearing.
- Please, please DO NOT confront anyone if you see something that is not being conformed to—let the Show Chair know of your concerns and they will be addressed.

# If you are mailing in your entry, this signed form MUST accompany the entry.

# Please read the following information prior to entering:

### Some tips regarding entering online via DogShow.ca:

- All entries via DogShow.ca are now "counted" at the precise time which payment is received. Therefore, even though many exhibitors can begin their entries right when entries open, those entries who complete their payment first will be the first to be accepted within the limited amount of entries.
- Because the expectation is that many people will be entering right at 9am on October 3, 2020, we suggest that you do not add dogs to your "cart" as these additions accumulate in longer times before payment is made. We suggest that you enter one dog at time and pay the entry fee one at a time to try to ensure entry.
- Because of a large mass of people could be submitting entries at one time, the system may be a little slow to accept the "submit" – please be patient – do not repeatedly click the "submit" icon as this could result in multiple entries of the same dog (shows could fill and close erroneously because of incorrect numbers).
- E-transfer payments take slightly less time during the entry process which can make a difference if you are entering multiple dogs.
- If you are sending entries in via mail, we prefer that you <u>pay via credit card</u> as this prevents the risks involved with multiple handling of paper and, as well, takes longer for payment to process.
- All entries MUST have the name of a handler/agent listed on the entry form even if you are handling your own dog.
  All entries MUST have the names of people in your party.
- All mailed-in entries MUST be completed including required information on separate forms, including signed Protocol Agreement(s) (one for each person in your party) failure to have ALL included and completed will result in the <u>entry not being accepted/processed</u>.

PLEASE NOTE: When completing entries, the name of the Handler MUST be included, even if it is you who are handling your own dog.

**REFUND POLICY**: If our November Show is unable to proceed as planned, then the Prince Albert Kennel Club will pay any Show related expenses we are unable to recoup, then disperse the balance evenly between the entries. We are very aware of everyone's financial constraints this year and the PAKOC Show Committee will continue to work diligently to mitigate any potential financial loss. ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

#### FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES:

All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

#### **OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS**

ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

#### **BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES**

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH CLASS: for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

**CANADIAN BRED**: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of <u>any</u> country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/cobreeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u>: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status <u>including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level</u>. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

EXHIBITION ONLY: for all dogs 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

**MOVING DOGS TO** "**SPECIALS ONLY**": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or agent at least 1 hour prior to the judging of the breed. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (Ranging from 0 - 5) and the number of championship points to credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more	*includes the dog awarded WINNERS
Points Allocated:	0	1	2	3	4	5	

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> (effective 2012) be included in the calculation of points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED a the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded Best Of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same class competition shall be included in the total. The number of Championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 20.2. In addition to Championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry from up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.



# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. There are to be no grooming tables, crates, trolleys, nor chairs at ringside.
- 2. <u>THE BOTTOMS OF ALL EX PENS AND WIRE CRATE BOTTOMS **MUST** BE LINED WITH PLASTIC SUPPLIED BY THE OWNER/HANDLER. A LIMITED AMOUNT OF PLASTIC CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE SHOW.</u>
- 3. Exhibitors are required to clean up their benching area upon leaving. Those who do not will be billed a \$50.00 clean-up fee which must be paid before entering future PAKOC events.
- 4. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building overnight; however, they will be left at the owner's/handler's own risk. There will be security on site. Please leave name and contact information in plain view at your benching site so that you may be contacted in necessary.
- As per CKC rules all dogs on the show premises *MUST be listed in the show catalogue*. Any dogs not listed will be asked to leave. If you have a dog at the show that is not entered you must obtain an "IN TRANSIT" ticket from the Show Secretary (no charge). <u>Because we have limited benching space, please leave your extra dogs at home.</u>
- 6. DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN THE <u>DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY</u>. NON-COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE SHOW. POOP/SCOOP RULES ARE **STRONGLY** IN EFFECT!
- 7. We recommend booking your Hotel Reservations early.
- 8. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary
- 9. Entry fees will not be refunded for cancellation of entries if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 10. If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 11. \*\*NOTE TIME!! The show building will be opened Thursday, at 4:00 PM (NO SOONER) to 11:00 PM for exhibitors to set up. \*\*The Club volunteers ask that you please wait until 4 pm before coming into the building so that they all have the time to complete what they need to do. The building will be open from 6:30 AM to 11:00 PM Fri, Sat + Sun; 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM on Mon.
- 12. Any show official, member, volunteer, employee or exhibitor shall not be subjected to any interaction which is deemed an indignity or disrespectful by anyone at these shows. This includes inappropriate volume, tone or language used. There will be a ZERO tolerance for this kind of behavior and should this occur, the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
- **13.** Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.
- 14. PLEASE NOTE MONDAY EXHIBITORS TO BE GONE FROM THE BUILDING BY 6PM.

# IMPORTANT REMINDER – BRING YOUR SIGNED WAIVERS TO THE SHOW TABLE UPON ARRIVAL AT THE VENUE – THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE VENUE/SHOW WITHOUT IT.
