BABY PUPPY COMPETITION will be judged separately,

on Saturday by Jerrica Coady after Show #1 & before Show #2. On Sunday by Kate Barnett after Show #1 & before Show #2.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (20.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes: It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulation. JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Sunday, June 21, 2026, Specialty Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all puppies at least four (4) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes or for Exhibition Only. Dogs will be judged in one of the following four (4) classes (divided by sex):

- at least 4 months of age up to but not including 6 months
- at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months
- at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months
- at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

REFUND POLICY

The Lady Slipper Kennel Club has instituted the following refund policies. Up to June 17, 2026, 8:00 am AST refunds should the show be cancelled shall be 80%. Remainder will be kept by the Club to cover costs. Once the show starts there shall be no refunds.

REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund, a letter from a practicing Veterinarian MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show.

REFUND INFORMATION ~ RALLY-OBEDIENCE (BITCHES IN SEASON)

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. The judge of a trial must remove from competition any bitch in season or any bitch that appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and the trial-giving club must refund the entry fee and listing fee providing the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

Junior Handling (Conformation)

LSKC Junior handling will be held on Saturday & Sunday, during the lunch break. All classes will be offered. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in the show in one of the regular classes or in exhibition only. To sign up to participate, do so, at the Show Secretary's table prior to 11:00 am. Entry Fee is \$2.00. Correct change ONLY as the Show Secretary does not maintain a cash float & will not be able to make change. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Catalogues

Pre-ordered catalogues are available at a cost \$15.00 (including HST) per copy and must be paid for at the time of entry. A limited number of catalogues will be available at the show for \$20.00, on a first-come-first-serve basis. Correct change ONLY as the Show Secretary does not maintain a cash float & will not be able to make change. Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors.

Rules

A copy of the rules pertaining to Conformation Shows or Rally-Obedience Trials may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). **Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.**

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.**

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership to CKC, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicated your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Please forward your request to:

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received on or before the closing date and time. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
3. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trials Secretary/Entry Service after the closing date and time.
6. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the CKC may compete in these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close. Please be sure your email is filled in & correct so that you receive these communications.
8. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Lady Slipper Kennel Club, its officers, associates and Show Committee, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. The Lady Slipper Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left in the building or on site overnight.
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials, which are governed by CKC rules.
- **The building will be open no earlier than 3:00 PM on Friday June 19th for set-up.** The building will be open at 7:00 AM daily.
- **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.**
- **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.**
- BAIT MUST NOT BE THROWN on the conformation ring floors.
- Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- **Please keep your dogs crated when unattended, and clean up after your dogs.**
- **SHOW & TRIAL PRECINCTS - The precincts of these shows and trials will be the building, the outdoor ring and its entrances.**
- **THERE IS TO BE NO OVERNIGHT PARKING OR OUTDOOR SET UPS IN PARKING LOT**

BEST OWNER/HANDLER COMPETITION (no extra fees for OH)

Saturday June 20, 2026 - Show 2

Rules for Owner Handler Competition

1. **Owner Handled MUST be selected** upon entry
2. This is open to all **non-professional** owner-handlers. Dogs must be OH throughout the competition on Saturday June 20, 2026.
3. **OH's** will be published in the catalogue and indicated on the Ring Steward sheets.
4. Judging of **OH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition.
5. **OH** Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB
6. If the BB is **OH**, it will automatically be the **OH BB**
7. If ineligible, then the next highest **OH** placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex
8. Should none of the BB competitive dogs be **OH**, then any **OH** dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an **OH** dogs) will be invited back
9. The **OH BB** dogs will compete for **OH in Group** immediately after Regular Group Judging
10. Should the Regular Group 1st dog be **OH**, then it will automatically be **OH in Group**
11. If no **OH** places in the Group (1-4), than all BB OH dogs will be called into the ring for **OH Group Judging**
12. If BIS dog is **OH**, then it will automatically be **OH BIS**
13. Rosette and Prize for Best OH in Show. Rosette for Best OH in Group. Flat ribbon for Best OH in Breed.

RALLY-OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Rally-Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Masters

(separate entry forms are required for each class entered and Jump Heights must be stated)

NOTE:

- 4-6-month Exhibition only puppy~ if the puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration Number the Listing Fee is waived.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS						

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

POINTS FOR RESERVE WINNERS FOR NATIONALS

At a single breed National Specialty, the male/female designated Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners to have received 5 points.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at any single show.

GRAND CHAMPIONS and GCH POINTS

15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group and Best in Show/Specialty level, to a maximum of 5 points.

a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of same sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch).

The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Select Dog = # of regular class dogs + # of specials dogs - 1, Select Bitch = # of regular class bitches + # of specials bitches - 1.

c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group and Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent and GCHEX Points

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) One (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) Three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) A CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, three (3) Group wins, or three (3) Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.

All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP in the Evangeline Community Centre building, on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.

Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground.
