ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - INFORMATION REGARDING TITLES:

The following has been copied from the CKC website:

Attention Canadian Residents

At the December Board meeting input provided by the membership was reviewed and considered to the board regarding the noticed posted to the CKC webiste on November 6, 2010 regarding a new Tracking feee for non-members. The Board has made changes to the original motion approved at the September Board meeting and the following motion was passed in December and therefore the following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011.

The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participatio nfee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the FRN fee.
- b) In rder to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS:

- All exhibitors, volunteers and spectators will respect each other's decision to wear protective masks if they so wish
- SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THE HOST'S PROPERTY violation of this rule will result in excusal from the trial grounds and could potentially lose the club access to the property for future events
- The Test precents will include the entire field area contained within the fence and gates as well as the potty area outside the green gate.
- There will be a \$10.00 fine for dogs loose on the field or on the host's property, including potty area. All dogs MUST be on a leash and secure collar/harness when outside their vehicle or on the track. All leashes must be held by a person, not attached to a ground stake or vehicle.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be marked absent with no refunds.
- Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. Per CKC rules, no prong or shock collars are permitted on test grounds. NO FLEXI or RETRACTABLE leashes permitted on test grounds.

- The only permitted collars during a dog's run are a flat, buckle collar with tags removed. The dog may also be run without a collar. Slip, half-check, or martingale or head collars are not permitted and will result in an NQ. Harnesses must be removed.
- People are expected to clean up after their dogs. There will be a \$20.00 fine for NOT cleaning up after your dog. Dogs are not to be off leash on the venue host's property at all, including areas outside of the defined Test precents. **Please do not let your dog urinate on the gates/gate posts, private vehicles or tents or anything else people have to handle.** There are plenty of trees to choose from.
- The field is mowed and will be enclosed by fencing.
- All exhibitors and spectators must remain away from the drag line and out of lure operator's marked area. The Event Officials will mark an area such that the lure line will not be interfered with and the lure operator will have clear line of sight of the entire field. This is a safety issue for exhibitors and their dogs.
- All exhibitors will follow Event Officials (Event Secretary, Lure Operator, Field Marshall, Event Chair) instructions. Refusal to comply will result in dismissal from the trial and grounds without refund of fees.

There will be NO canteen on site. All attendees will need to bring their own water, drinks and food.



PARKING

Gates will open at 8am each day.

Exhibitors will be expected to park on the hill outside the fence if they arrive before the previous group has finished. The preceding group will be permitted to leave the field before the following group enters the field. This is to alleviate the congestion at the gate and at the start line end of the field. Parking along the north fence is to be utilized first before starting a second row down the center of the field.

A trial volunteer will indicate to the people waiting outside the gate when they may enter the field. The vehicle gate is to stay CLOSED at all times while a dog is running the course.


Drivers are to obey all directions from trial committee as to where to park.

How Will This Test Work?

First, the Secretary will assign each entry a group number. This number will be relayed to

The handler's meeting will be delivered via email on the Friday evening before the test. It is the handler's responsibility to read and understand. The secretary's phone will be available for calls, however, she will be setting up on the field and it may be better to text her.

On the day of the Test, dogs will be brought to the field at the time indicated for their Group number. DO NOT arrive before your group time. Competitors will not be allowed on the field until the prior group has exited. There will be no spectators permitted as part of our effort to manage our gathering size and comply with provincial regulations. Dogs are permitted ONE (1) handler to release them and ONE (1) catcher to retrieve them.
