Dogs not registered in Canada must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a field trial.

TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online or by contacting toll free 1-855-364-7252.

The listing fee for unregistered dogs is \$10.50 per dog per entry.

Canadian resident non CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.

Scratches will be refunded for a bitch in season totally. All other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$10.00.

LOCATION: The Trial will be held in the River Valley near the junction of Hwy 3 and Hwy 509 10 Kms. West of Lethbridge, Alberta (See map). Postal code area T0L 0V0

The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
