NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of **\$25.00**. **N.S.F.** cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.
