ENTRY INFORMATION: HST included per dog, per test, per day, see above. Listing fee of \$11.30 (HST Inc.) for Temporary Competition Number (TCN) dogs without an individual CKC registration number, or PEN/ERN/CCN number must also be submitted. Major stake fee includes \$5.00 levy for NRCC

Do not mail or courier entries directly to the secretary. Do not email entries or e-transfer payment to the secretary. Such entries will NOT be accepted.

Refunds will be given in bitches in season or dogs determined by a veterinarian to be unfit to compete. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the test.

Catalogue, running orders and test site addresses will be posted on dogshow.ca and NPRTC facebook page after closing

GAME: Dead ducks will be used in all stakes. Depending on their availability, dead pheasants may also be used.

RUNNING ORDER: We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on April 30 as a starting number for the first series of All Age Stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotations thereafter in the All Age Stakes. Rotation may be used in Qualifying / Junior at the judges discretion.

AWARDS: CKC rosettes will be awarded to all placing dogs in each stake. CKC rosettes will also be awarded to dogs earning a Certificate of Merit.

CKC INFORMATION: NPRTC is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada and dogs placing in our CKC approved Licensed Trial will be eligible to compete in the National Stakes. ***Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Field Trials:*** Sec. 21.7 – 'It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS: By entering this Trial each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to the participation in the Trial and agrees to release and save harmless and indemnify the owners of any property upon which the Trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and Representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participants howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.

Running orders, callbacks and results may be posted on our Facebook page. Catalogues will be available from the marshal at all stakes. NPRTC will not be holding tailgate.
