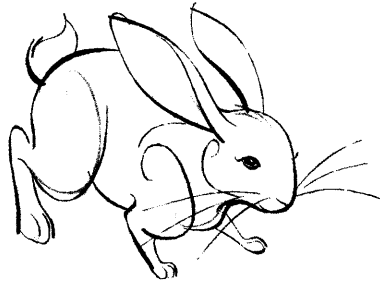
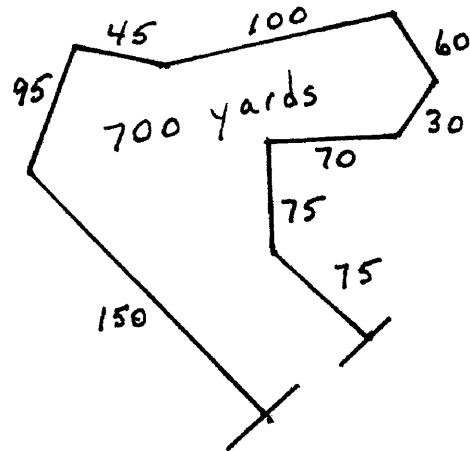

Eligibility

Only purebred Irish Wolfhounds may be entered. All hounds entered must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. Hounds not registered with the CKC must pay an \$8.40 Listing Fee per trial/per day/ until CKC registration is obtained. Altered and neutered hounds may compete. **HOUNDS PRESENTLY DISQUALIFIED IN CANADA OR THE U.S. ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE OFFICIAL STAKES BUT MAY ENTER THE SINGLES STAKE.**

Equipment

A gas or battery powered DRAG lure machine with white plastic bags will be used.

Conditions

Stakes will be split if there are more than 24 hounds entered at the time of the draw. All hounds will run twice in braces or trios unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season or lame hounds will be excused, and any entry refunded if notice is given before or during Roll Call. Hounds not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees not refunded. Handlers must use slip leads when starting their hounds. Muzzles and/or catch collars may be used at owner's discretion. All hounds will be slipped from a standing start.

Stakes Offered:

Official – see Championship Points below

OPEN - for all hounds.

FIELD CHAMPION – for all hounds with a CKC F.Ch. title

Unofficial – no points awarded

Singles Stake – 1st thru 4th, NBQ – hounds will run singly twice on a full course.

Puppy Stake – Rosette for: 1st place Junior, 1st Place Senior, 1st place Yearling and Best Overall. Puppies will run singly once on a shortened course.

Kennel Stake – Highest combined score from the Open and/or F.Ch. runs (2 hounds, same owner)

Breeder Stake – Highest combined score from the Open and/or F.Ch. runs (2 hounds, same breeder)

Championship Points

Championship points in Official Stakes shall be awarded on the basis of the following:

1st Place..... 4 x # of hounds competing – max. 40 points

2nd Place..... 3 x # of hounds competing – max. 30 points

3rd Place..... 2 x # of hounds competing – max. 20 points

4th Place..... 1 x # of hounds competing – max. 10 points

NBQ..... No points awarded

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

Heritage Park is located just off the Trans-Canada Highway at Exit 116.

Travelling from the West take Exit 116, at the lights turn Right onto Lickman Rd and almost immediately Left onto Luckakuck Way. Enter the site on the right and watch for signs.

Travelling from the East take Exit 116 and at the lights turn Left onto Lickman Rd, over the overpass and down to Luckakuck Way, turn left.

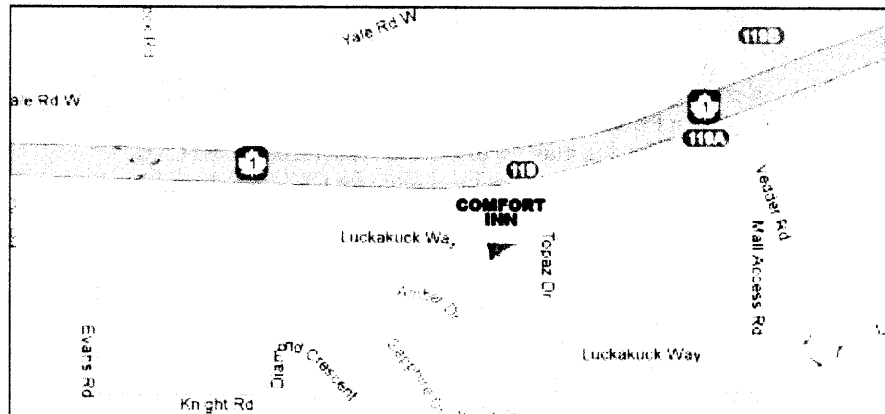

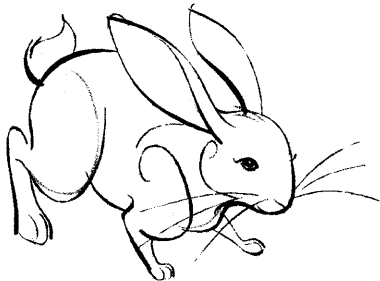
As you see from the map below the campgrounds are right next door to the site.



Notes

- American Exhibitors – You need an up-to-date rabies certificate dated not less than 30 days but not more than 3 years to cross the border.
- American Exhibitors – Our bank will not accept cheques marked “Payable in Canadian Funds”. We suggest purchasing a Foreign Bank Draft payable in Canadian Currency.
- IWCC appreciates everyone’s cooperation in keeping our site clean. There will be a \$5.00 fine for anyone caught not cleaning up after his or her hound.
- There will also be a \$5.00 fine for any loose dog interfering with a course in progress.
- *“A judge officiating at a field trial under these rules and regulations (CKC) shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the field trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the field trial to see that this regulation is effectively carried out. The Field Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this regulation has been violated.”*

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but may obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-born and foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. The ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as “listed”, however failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. To obtain an ERN send a photocopy of the dog’s registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN. Include cheque, money order or credit card authorization for \$58.30. Ensure you have included full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Forward your request to:

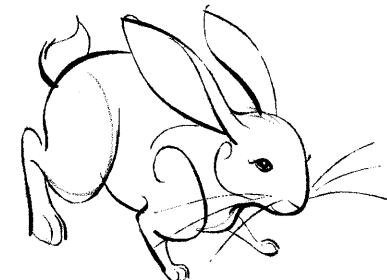

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

A Performance Event Number (PEN allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience Trials, Tracking Tests, Herding Trials, Draft Dog Tests, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Tests, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Tests, and Pointing Field Dog Tests. In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:

1. The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC.
2. The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
3. The dog must be spayed or neutered.
4. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (except dogs with an ILP number).
5. In the case of a foreign-owned dog residing in the US, the dog must have an AKC ILP number.

Waiver of Requirement: This requirement will be waived for a hound that has earned a lure coursing title from another organization if such title required competition, and if a waiver for such title has been approved by the Canadian Kennel Club. If your hound qualifies for a waiver complete the top half of this form and attach to your entry form,

All hounds must be a minimum of 11 months of age prior to being certified.
 All hounds must run a normal course of 600 yards in order to be certified.
