

#### **ROSETTES & PRIZES:**

A Rosette and Prize will be awarded to all New Titles. Dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons (flat).

#### DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES:

Day of trial entries will be accepted as space allows and must be submitted prior to the judges briefing (8:30am). Day of entries shall be \$35.00 per component and only cash or e-transfer to <u>albertadobermanpinscherclub@gmail.com</u> will be accepted on the day of the trial. Move ups within the same trial ie: Novice to Open are not permitted. A prize and ribbon are not guaranteed for day of entries, however any ribbons earned will be sent out post-trial if required.

#### **BITCHES IN SEASON:**

If you have a bitch in season, we MUST BE NOTIFIED to move you to the end of the run order!

#### VENUE:

<u>No indoor benching available</u>. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). Remember that this is a public facility and a place of business. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event. Stairs may need to be used to access the search areas. If you need assistance, please let one of our stewards know!

WASHROOM FACILITIES: Facilities are available indoors.

#### CKC REGULATION:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or available to view with the Event Secretary.

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations as set out by the CKC apply.

#### ODOR ON SITE:

9.3.13 No person other than the Judge or Hide Steward shall use of any of the target odours when on the trial grounds. Any person using target odours on the grounds who is not the Judge or Hide Steward may be excused from the trial and asked to leave the trial grounds.
